1. The iTOTO Game

- An iTOTO bet is a Quick Pick System 12 Entry divided into 28 units. Each unit costs \$33 (cost of a System 12 Entry of \$924 divided by 28).
- A System 12 Entry is a TOTO bet with 12 numbers ranging from 1 to 49 in each selection.
- The prize amount for each winning iTOTO unit is the prize amount of the winning Quick Pick System 12 Entry divided by 28.
- All units of an existing iTOTO bet must be sold before a new iTOTO bet is generated upon demand.
- The prize amount will be rounded up to the nearest 10 cents.

2. The 4D Game

- To play 4D, select a four-digit number from 0000 to 9999.
- The minimum cost is \$1.
- Draws for winning 4D numbers take place every Wednesday, Saturday and Sunday at 6.30pm.
- 23 sets of winning 4D numbers across five prize categories are drawn during each draw.
- If you have placed bets on any of the 23 winning 4D numbers, you win a prize.

3. Placing a 4D Bet via the Telephone

- Up to four boards per transaction and up to 12 boards per call can be placed.
- Both Self Pick and Quick Pick bets can be chosen.
- A series of voice prompts will help customers enter their lottery selections using the phone number pad.

a. The Telephone 4D Quick Pick Bet

- The computer system will randomly select four digits in a bet selection.

b. The Telephone 4D Quick Pick Roll Bet

- The computer system will randomly select three digits and one rolling digit.
- The rolling digit, designated by 'R', represents any number from '0' to '9'.
