DISCO BEATS makes some appeal on his narrow beating over 5f on debut at Pontefract, though he does need to step up on his last run at Ripon, when upped to 6f, in order to figure. Amaying Eyes is entitled to come on for her debut spin at Redcar and could take closer order, though the main dangers may be lurking among the newcomers and money for Moiella or Midnight Stripper would be interesting.

C&D winner Royal Brave has also slipped to a good mark and can fight it out with the dropped-in-trip Antagonize for the silver medal.

Influence Is Power needs to leave his Beverley debut run behind, though Richard Fahey's newcomer, Boundsy Boy, would be interesting if the market vibes were positive.

After finishing a close-up fourth at Haydock recently, Innings could similarly take a hand.

Asdaa is rated 3lb higher than when winning on the all-weather in February but has place claims, likewise the eased-in-grade Gabrial The Wire.
