Fairview, 03.07.2020, Race 1, Gallops, 1000m, Turf, R35.000, 12:15GMT+2

Race Summary: Mostly newcomers in this opening event and a keen eye will have to be kept on the betting as there are 3 Gimmethegreenlight fillies and it would not be a surprise were 1 of them to win. Trainer Gavin Smith has 2 runners that have racing experience and both DEHAB and JUST SO EASY are capable of showing improvement and must be given some respect.

Race Summary: A weak field and it would not be much of a surprise were HOT TIN ROOF proved to be a bit better than her rivals. She may have just needed her last run when fifth at Greyville but even that form is good enough to win a maiden at this centre. OFF PAT was not disgraced when third on the Polytrack on debut but will need to show that form trying the turf this time. She is the biggest threat to the selection.

Race Summary: Mostly moderate, battling maidens. AMAZING TUNE has run 2 good races since joining trainer Grant Paddock and this could well be his best chance of getting out of the Maiden ranks. MOUNT EVEREST ran on well over further last time out but can sprint and will be a danger. ANDREA has a place chance. TIME STANDS STILL makes his debut and could well be the right one.

Race Summary: CASUAL WEAR is back on the turf and an improved run from her could be on the cards. WILD MOVE is unreliable but is also not out of it. VARSITY BOURBON is unbeaten in 2 starts over this track and distance so deserves the utmost respect. BUSHY PARK needed her last run and could improve. GO GOODFELLOW can upset. ESCAPE TO VEGAS returns from a break but does have a winning chance.

Race Summary: A decent field. FOREIGN SOURCE returns from a break but is the one to beat, DUTCH PHILIP is battling to win but could finish in the money. HOOVES OF TROY is consistent and should again be right there at the finish. Trainer Alan Greeff also sends out KIMBERLEY STAR, VIKING MOON and VERBARIUM as good back up to FOREIGN SOURCE and they cannot be ignored away easily.

Race Summary: GLOBAL DRUMMER is unbeaten in 2 starts at this course and his blemish in between those wins was at Kenilworth so he should be the one to beat. Stable companions easy debut winner BRAZIL NUT and the consistent FIREVIEW clearly have some ability and must be considered. TARANTINO is improving and was scratched from his intended run on Friday so clearly deserves a lot of respect in this race.

Race Summary: The now Listed East Cape Derby is one of the highlights of the Eastern Caperacing season and it has not been too often that a filly has won this but AMERICAN PRINCESS does look the one they all have to beat. She was impressive in her last win and she should have no problem with the distance. Western Cape based runners always have to be respected when raiding and the hat-trickseeking AUGUST LEAVES is the biggest threat to the filly.

Race Summary: The Yvette Bremner trained NATIONAL PARK is a smashing horse who has won 6 of his 13 starts so far but is returning from a break of more than a year and is taken on by the champ. Stable companion LEGAL EAGLE clearly needed his local debut on the Polytrack but could bounce back to winning form over a distance that clearly suits him. EARTH HOUR is doing well at this centre and can finish in the money once again.

Race Summary: Clearly the toughest race to find a winner on this card is this lucky last race and wide spread of runners will be needed to survive the exotics. MIO GRANDE gives weight away to all his rivals but can pop up and score if in the mood. SUNDAY FALLS ran well enough last time out to have a winning chance. MALDIVES, BENGAL CRIMSON, HUMOUR ME and STREETFIGHTING MAN are also not out of it.
