R11 - HAYDOCK PARK | 20:50 | GBP £100,000 | BETTER ODDS ON THE BETFAIR EXCHANGE HANDICAP

| 1 | FIRST IN LINE | Had a winning run broken last time out when second at York. Rates well at peak fitness. Looks the one to beat. |
| 4 | CALCULATION | In form stayer who brought up a hat-trick of wins with success at Chelmsford last start. Form excellent and expected to be in the finish. |
| 6 | LAAFY | Progressive and lightly raced colt. Last time recorded a 2.75 lengths win over 2800m at Nottingham. Rates well and is worth including in the multiples. |
| 9 | GABRIALS BOY | Broke maiden status at latest outing when winning at Ripon over 1970m, and faces a rise in class this start. Gets in well at the weights after a 1.5kg claim. Can run into a place. |
| 5 | MOON KING | Consistent galloper who has won five of ten career runs, last start finishing first over 2890m at Chester. Has the ability and is a definite each way hope. |

| 4 | SHARJA BRIDGE | Coming back to racing after three months off. Goes well when resuming. Can take this. |
| 2 | MATTERHORN | Boasts the peak Timeform rating in this field. Went down by half a length to finish second at Windsor over 2000m last start. Will take beating. |
| 6 | MISS O CONNOR | Won three of three career runs to date, the latest finishing first over 1640m at this track. Has the ability and is a definite each way hope. |
| 5 | WHAT'S THE STORY | Broke through for a deserved win last time over 1590m at York and rarely far away. Won last start and looks well suited again. |
| 3 | RAISING SAND | Returned to winning form last time when scoring by a head over 1400m at Ascot. Going well and could measure up again. |

| 8 | SESAME BIRAH | Ran well last start when just out of the market at \$17.00 at Newbury over 1400m. Looks well suited. |
| 2 | LIGHT ANGEL | Beaten by a half a length when second at Chelmsford on 1400m in latest effort. Looks a good chance on that form. |
| 6 | SUBJECTIVIST | Progressive and lightly raced colt. Last time recorded a 2 length second over 1600m at Salisbury. Rates well and is among the chances. |
| 3 | PYLEDRIVER | Has run home well in both career starts suggesting the step up to 1640m here will be right up his gate. Watch for him rattling home once again. |
| 4 | SHARED BELIEF | Lightly raced colt progressing well. Last start posted a 3.75 lengths third over 1600m at Deauville. Has the ability and is a definite each way hope. |

| 1 | CORELLI | Lightly raced gelding progressing well. Last start posted a head second over 2390m at York. Has the ability and expected to run well. |
| 8 | ALRIGHT SUNSHINE | Shooting for a hat-trick of wins after making it two on end with 1.25 lengths win over 2820m at Musselburgh. In great form and can go on with it here. |
| 3 | BLAKENEY POINT | Handy stayer racing below best including last start when well held over 3260m at York on August 21. Rates highly here though and expected to improve sharply. |
| 12 | RESTORER | Could only manage 15th at York last start. Can expect a better run this time out. |
| 6 | RESHOUN | Handy stayer racing below best including last start when well held over 2410m at Ascot on August 10. Decent overall record and could sneak a placing. |
