

TIP SHEET

AUSTRALIA - 10th July 2019

R1 - WARWICK FARM | 12:35 | AUD \$50,000 | TAB (BM66)

1	KNOWITALL JACK	Fresh off a small break. Yet to miss a minor placing in two resuming runs. No reason he can't run another big race resuming.
6	SOUTHERN ROMANCE	Has been racing well in recent times including a win two starts back at Randwick-Kensington before running third at Randwick-Kensington last start. Going well at present and is not to be discounted.
7	DEBATE	Won narrowly by a long neck last time out at Hawkesbury but will have to carry more weight. Top contender.
9	LICKO'PAINT	Was prominent throughout at Canterbury, working to the line in good fashion to finish fourth. Wasn't far off the winner there. Can be thereabouts at the finish again here. Worth thought.
2	A MILLION DREAMS	Yet to break through this campaign but hasn't been far away including a last start second over 1300m at Hawkesbury. Going well and is a must for the multiples.

R2 - GRAFTON | 12:50 | AUD \$40,000 | JACARANDA HOTEL COUNTRY MDN

4	MASPOETA	Promising colt with placings at both career runs to date. Last start was second over 1530m at Murwillumbah. Rates highly looks hard to beat.
14	IN A STEP	Second up in this. Has drawn a very wide gate in this but still looks a winning hope.
7	MORINGA'S HIEMIE	Three runs this campaign have each had merit despite being unable to shed his maiden tag. Should be nice and fit fourth up and can get the win here.
2	GUS LIGHTNING	A maiden after seven career runs, the latest finishing sixth over 1005m at Coffs Harbour. Rates highly on best form though and bold showing expected.
11	RUNAMUK	Running well recently including a last start third by 1.2 lengths over 1000m at Casino. Rates well and is among the chances.

R3 - WARWICK FARM | 13:10 | AUD \$50,000 | ALL TOO HARD @ VINERY (BM70)

1	MONASTERIO	Broke a drought when returning to winning form last start over 1550m at Randwick-Kensington. Back in form and expected to run well again.
10	BLACK AND TAN	Was in traffic last time after seventh on the turn to place over 1400m at Randwick-Kensington. Will be winding up strongly.
2	PELETHRONIUS	Started this campaign with poor form, last start recording sixth by 4.5 lengths over 1400m at Randwick. Easier here and gets chance to show form.
3	SONAREE	Finished midfield but beaten only 1.3 lengths when seventh over 1900m at Canterbury. Rates well and is in the mix.
7	ANDAZ	Was prominent throughout at Randwick-Kensington, working to the line in good fashion to finish second. Wasn't far off the winner there. Looks capable of fighting out the finish again here.

R4 - GRAFTON | 13:25 | AUD \$80,000 | TURSA GRAFTON GUINEAS

1	COMMANDER	Likes the distance and goes well with multiple placings. Rates strongly here and expected to go close.
2	LIGULATE	Good effort when fourth at Caulfield over 1440m last start. Has been racing in much tougher company of late. Should be a strong chance here on that form. Must be respected.
5	DULETTE	Going well lately, the latest 0.8 lengths win over 1400m at Rosehill. Honest type with three wins to his name already. Racing well and expected to measure up.
3	LEGION OF BOOM	Progressive and lightly raced gelding. Last time recorded a 2 length win over 1300m at Scone. Rates well and is among the chances.
4	CHARMED PRINCESS	Three-year-old filly who was a 0.8 lengths winner over 1410m at this track last time. Last start winner and on strong record at this track is a definite winning hope again.

R5 - WARWICK FARM | 13:45 | AUD \$50,000 | EVEREST CARNIVAL (BM70)

5	SELES	Missed the placings last time over a longer trip when seventh over 1400m at Randwick-Kensington. Thereabouts lately and expected to go close.
1	TYCOON STREET	Four-year-old mare still chasing her first win in metropolitan company. Place looks best chance in this.
2	SWEET AVA	Poor winning strike rate overall with just one win from 12 starts, latest was sixth over 1300m at this track. Rates highly on best form and expected to go close.
3	CUBAN SIZZLE	Ran well last start when not overly favoured at \$17 at Randwick over 1200m. Can go close.
6	VINNIE POWER	Likes the distance and goes well with multiple placings. Continues to improve. Looks suited.

R6 - GRAFTON | 14:00 | AUD \$160,000 | RAMORNIE HCP

1	CARE TO THINK	Consistent type resuming here after 207 day break and has won first up before. Trialled at Deagon over 1000m in readiness for this. Has to be included on known ability.
3	BON AMIS	Resumed with a solid second over 1100m on June 8 before disappointing as favourite last time. First up rating makes him the one to beat here.
7	SNOOPY	Won barrier trial on June 20 and resumes here after 130 day break. Multiple first-up winner previously. Capable of another win but can only take on trust.
19	STAR BOY	Honest type who lines up in this as a last start winner but facing a stiffer assignment here. Harder here and place is preferred.

R7 - WARWICK FARM | 14:20 | AUD \$50,000 | EXOSPHERE @ DARLEY (BM70)

8	THE PARTY GIRL	Missed the placings last time over a longer trip when fourth over 1550m at Randwick-Kensington. Thereabouts lately and expected to go close.
2	METAMORPHIC	Far from disgraced when fourth at Rosehill last start after finishing third two runs back only beaten a neck. Distance rise should suit and looms as a threat in this.
6	MUSUME	Winner two starts back at Hawkesbury which was followed up with a close fifth at Canterbury. Going well at present and is not to be discounted.
4	PEMBROKE CASTLE	Was positioned right up near the speed last start working home well for a second at Newcastle. Wasn't beaten by far in that affair. Worth some thought here on the back of latest performance.
11	HE'S A GIVEN	Seasoned galloper who is an 7 time winner and ran a solid race last time when a 0.8 lengths second over 1400m at Hawkesbury. Thereabouts last time and is worth including in the multiples.

R8 - GRAFTON | 14:35 | AUD \$30,000 | GROUP 1 FEEDS HCP (C2)

1	MISS SCORCHER	Back from a five months spell following 5.75 lengths sixth over 1100m at Warwick Farm. Consistent fresh up record and expected to prove hard to beat.
4	DIXIE	Honest galloper who returned from a spell with a head win over 1005m at Coffs Harbour. Strong winning strike rate and looks a leading player again.
3	FRIENDS OF WREN	First up in this. Strong campaign last preparation saluting the judge two times. Likely to be shy of her best first up but still rates as a leading contender.
5	LADY CLARE	Out of the placings last time when eighth over a longer 1106m trip at this track. Rates well and definitely worth including in the multiples.
2	POLYXENA	Mare who races well and following a disappointing sixth over 1250m at Canterbury went for a break. Form sound for this and is among the hopes.
