Vaal, 11.07.2019, Race 1, Gallops, 1000m, Turf, R105.000, 12:40GMT+2

Race Summary: SARAH has the form. She comes of a rest and even if not at peak fitness should be hard to peg back. SEEMYVISION won this course and distance and looks the main danger. TRUE CHARM won easily on debut in Kimberley and should be preferred ahead of stable mates SHE CAN DANCE and CODE BLACK. Maiden ALLMYLOVING could take home a cheque. Newcomers could place here.

URBAN ROCK worked hard for a debut victory but would have gained valuable experience. GUANTANAMO BAY hasn't been disgraced in feature events and could get into the mix.

ON MY MIND has been knocking from day one 1 and runner-up in his last 3 - obvious chance. MOUNT RAINIER disappointed over further last time but is back over a preferred trip. LION KING has a shout if covered early. Others with money claims.

should do a lot better. ARCHILLES could feature if not troubled by breathing. Many are looking for money including STAR PROFILE, SUPA MUFTI and TRUE WORDS.

Luck in running could be the decider. MONOPOLIZE runs well for Gavin and despite 62kg on his back could take it. FINCHATTON, ROCK OF AFRICA, SAIL FOR JOY, CERTIFIABLE and NORLAND are not out of it.
