RACE 10: UNIBET THANKS THE FRONTLINE WORKERS NURSERY (CLASS 5) (2YO ONLY) (FROM KEMPTON RACE 1)

Unbutton                      For Peat's Sake                      Temple Bruer

UNBUTTON shades the verdict in a competitive-looking nursery. She has shaped encouragingly on her last couple of starts and an opening mark of 75 might be underestimating her ability. For Peat's Sake ran well enough on his debut over this trip and two subsequent 5f efforts haven't been without promise. He merits a place on the shortlist as do Ascot third Temple Bruer and Stay Smart, who wears a tongue-tie for the first time.

She looks to have a bright future and should go well under a penalty here, but giving 7lb and a beating to ownermate ISLE OF MAY is a big ask. Both of her placed efforts read well and it will be disappointing if she doesn't make it third-time lucky. Lucid Dreamer makes most appeal of the newcomers.

Ice Eagle Model Guest Ilalliqa ICE EAGLE justified strong market support when scoring over this trip at Redcar last month and, with further improvement to come, she could follow up under a penalty. Model Guest is much more exposed, but this is only her second start for Archie Watson and she went close in a Sandown maiden 10 days ago. The red-hot Hollie Doyle is booked and she is likely to be in the mix again, while Ilalliqa and Mostly are others to watch out for.

MAY SONIC appeared to benefit from the return to more positive tactics when getting back to winning ways at Windsor at the end of last month. She went up 6lb for that effort and could have more to come if ridden similarly on this occasion. Last Surprise's best form has come over this distance and she is respected on her first run since February, while Split Down South can enter the reckoning having been in great form earlier in the year.
