### **RACE 1: ROSSDALES BRITISH EBF MAIDEN FILLIES' STAKES (PLUS 10)**

Light Blush    Ennistymon    Baaqy

Ennistymon didn't have the smoothest of passages on her Curragh introduction and much better is expected, but perhaps a chance can be taken on LIGHT BLUSH. By Kodiak out of a dual Listed winner over 1m2f, there is a nice blend of speed and stamina in her pedigree, and she changed hands for 435,000gns as a yearling. Baaqy, Believe In Love, Frankel's Storm and Award Scheme are other newcomers to consider in a maiden that can throw up a good one.

**RACE 2: BET365 MILE HANDICAP**

HONEST ALBERT hadn't been seen since making a successful debut on the all-weather seven months earlier, but he showed that he has a very bright future by swatting aside odds-on favourite Bayroot at Nottingham and it should be a case of onwards and upwards. Bayroot is 5lb worse off so the biggest threat could come in the shape of Motakhayyel, who bumped into a smart John Gosden prospect at Yarmouth. Akwaan steps up in class after completing a brace at the same seaside circuit, and Hamilton winner/Britannia sixth Victory Command can't be dismissed lightly either.

Ropey Guest fared slightly better than Maxi Boy in the Coventry but the suspicion immediately after the race was that it may not be the strongest renewal. Year Of The Tiger also went to the Royal meeting, finishing seventh in the Chesham, before scoring at Naas, but they come across a clutch of interesting once-raced winners. Mystery Power might be the pick of the Hannon pair, while Shared Belief and Juan Elcano did it well at Sandown and Haydock respectively, but KING'S COMMAND overcame trouble over 6f here and should relish the extra furlong.

KYNREN came in for plenty of support for the Hunt Cup but was drawn on the wrong side so did well to finish fifth. He had the misfortune to bump into potential Group performers in top handicaps before that, and today could be his day. Solar Gold has been picking up minor money in Listed company, while Spanish City will appreciate the rise from 6f. Burnt Sugar's campaign is likely to have been geared around this again, and Roger Fell has a very good second string in Admiralty. Ambassadorial made the best possible start to life with Jane Chapple-Hyam by winning at Chelmsford but although he is well treated on grass, he is yet to prove his mettle on the surface.
