## R1 - GUNNEDAH | 12:40 | AUD \$22,000 | BOGGABRI BUSINESS HOUSES MDN

| 1 | CRIME WAVE   | Performing well since debut placing two races from three starts and could lose maiden status this start.  |
| 4 | ANOTHER ARLI | Made steady improvement at second career start, boxing on strongly to finish third over 1400m at Tamworth. Form good for this and rates as a major player.    |
| 9 | MILO'S CHARM | Consistently outside the placings of late, latest was fifth beaten by 2.25 lengths over 900m at Scone. Rates well enough today to score.                      |
| 7 | DANETIST     | Thirteen start maiden who was ninth over 1600m at Sunshine Coast and drops in weight for this. Comes into calculations.                                       |
| 5 | CAVEMAN      | Made a strong run to finish seventh over 1200m at Tamworth and will relish the extra ground here. Ready to peak after two runs back and should be in the mix. |

## R2 - TAREE | 13:05 | AUD \$22,000 | TAB (BM58)

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| 11 | EUROGEM       | Has been racing well in recent times including a win two starts back at Port Macquarie before running fourth at Port Macquarie last start. Going well at present and is not to be discounted. |
| 3  | JUSTICE HONOR | Stepping out to this course for the first time but rates well at this distance. Likely to prove hard to hold out.   |
| 9  | DELCHUZY      | Returned to form placing second last time out when well in the market at this track over 1614m. Making headway every start. Rates strongly.   |
| 2  | UP THE STAIRS | Looks close to a win following a 1500m placing at Port Macquarie where he ran on well for third beaten 1.1 lengths. Rates highly and should feature with repeat of latest.                    |
| 4  | OPINIONS      | Made a strong run to finish sixth over 1600m at Wyong and will relish the extra ground here. Rates strongly here and is among the chances.  |

## R3 - GUNNEDAH | 13:20 | AUD \$22,000 | COMMERCIAL HOTEL BOGGABRI MDN

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| 4  | LILY'S GOLD       | Finished midfield but beaten only 2 lengths when eighth over 1100m at Scone. Has the ability and rates among the leading hopes.                                      |
| 8  | FANTASTIC FILLE   | Well in the market last but ran well below best when a 9.25 lengths tenth over 1400m at Scone. Below par latest but may be worth another chance.                     |
| 11 | MISS DUBLEO SEVEN | Handy mare racing in good form, finished midfield last time when fifth but beaten only 1.2 lengths over 1200m. Rates highly here and looks one of the major players. |
| 14 | SMOKEBALL         | Solid effort last start showing good ability. Up in the weights now but still appeals as well treated and should take plenty from that run. Genuine chance.          |
| 13 | OURASIANPRINCESS  | Not beaten far in latest when sixth at Dubbo. Definite contender.  |

## R4 - TAREE | 13:40 | AUD \$22,000 | WIN TELEVISION MDN HCP

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| 3 | TOGUCHI        | Performing well since debut placing three races from three starts and could lose maiden status this start.   |
| 6 | WHATSIN        | Placed in a trial and worth keeping safe. Profiles well for this and expected to measure up.   |
| 2 | STONECOLD FLEX | Kept coming last time over 1200m at Tamworth to finish fifth and will appreciate the extra ground here. Should be at peak fitness now and may be worth another chance. |
| 1 | SEBAGO         | Resumed at Port Macquarie over 1100m and missed the frame, finishing fourth and beaten 4 lengths. Should strip much fitter and rates among the chances on best form.   |
| 8 | ALWAYS HOT     | Started this campaign with poor form, last start recording fifth by 3.5 lengths over 1100m at Port Macquarie. Has the ability and can bounce back.                     |

**R5 - GUNNEDAH | 13:55 | AUD \$22,000 | COMMERCIAL HOTEL BOGGABRI-BM58**

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| <b>3</b> | DENACE         | Ran below best last time when finishing midfield and is overdue for a win, placing at two of four start this preparation. Better than last start and rates a leading player here.            |
| <b>2</b> | POMME LA BELLE | Could manage only midfield last time at Tamworth but has been going pretty well without winning, with placings at two of four runs this time in. Rates highly here and worth another chance. |
| <b>1</b> | DUSKY DAMSEL   | Going well lately, the latest half a length second over 1000m at Dubbo. Honest type with three wins to her name already. Rates highly here and is right in the mix again.                    |
| <b>4</b> | SOLAR PANEL    | Returned from a spell last start when runner up beaten 2.25 lengths at Glen Innes on January 11 over 1200m. Winning chance.  |
| <b>5</b> | APACHE BELLE   | Settled back but kept coming to finish eighth over 1350m at Scone. Looks well placed here and should be in the mix.  |

**R6 - TAREE | 14:20 | AUD \$22,000 | CTRY C'SHIP HT@TAREE 23/2-BM66**

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| <b>3</b> | ACOUSTIX       | Well rated gelding. Scored a close win last start at Port Macquarie winning by a head starting at \$3.30. Major player.   |
| <b>8</b> | EYEBEA DANSER  | Fairly honest mare but does find it hard to win. Course and distance winner, the latest when fifth over 1250m at this track. Has the ability and rates among the leading chances. |
| <b>6</b> | JAMAICAN DREAM | Has been racing on the pace at his two starts in. Ready to improve now and has won over this distance. The one to beat.   |
| <b>7</b> | CARTEL         | Resumed over 1000m and missed the placings when a 3.5 lengths sixth at this track. Further improved and expected to do much better here.  |
| <b>9</b> | ROGUE MISSILE  | Resuming from a spell following a half a length win over 1415m at Coffs Harbour. Recent placed in a trial and shouldn't be far away.  |

**R7 - GUNNEDAH | 14:35 | AUD \$22,000 | HAIRE'S BUS SERVICES (BM58)**

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| <b>1</b>  | CAPTAIN EYCHE      | Has not been far away in recent times and was a last start winner at Tamworth. Should be competitive this start, looks well placed.   |
| <b>10</b> | WHONICKED DE LOLLY | Just one career win from 25 starts, last time when a 3 length fifth over 1000m at Tamworth. Rates highly here and expected to do much better.   |
| <b>11</b> | IN A SPRING        | Resumed at Muswellbrook over 1000m and missed the frame, finishing fifth and beaten 3.75 lengths. Rates highly and should be a sharp improver. Fitter for the run and expected to be in the finish this time. |
| <b>3</b>  | TENNESSEE MAN      | Resumes after a two months break when finishing fifth over 1600m at this track. Rates highly and looks one of the leading chances.  |
| <b>4</b>  | ZAMALI             | Finished midfield over 1100m at Forbes last time, 3.25 lengths from the winner. The weight drop will help with the longer trip this time. Rates well and is worth including among the chances.                |

**R8 - TAREE | 14:55 | AUD \$22,000 | IRON JACK HCP (C1)**

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| <b>1</b>  | HUBBLE        | Poor winning strike rate overall with just one win from 20 starts, latest was third over 1200m at Tamworth. Rates highly on best form and expected to be in the finish. |
| <b>5</b>  | ZELLYMAY      | Made an ideal start to her career, scoring a debut win at Port Macquarie. Sets the standard here  |
| <b>2</b>  | GIN RUNNER    | Kicked off latest campaign well at Cowra when third on January 19 over 1100m. Improved by first up run. Top chance.   |
| <b>9</b>  | GOLD BRACELET | Strategic Maneuver filly who made debut at \$26.00 with a win over 1005m at this track. Shows ability and could sneak into the finish.                                  |
| <b>12</b> | QUEEN GINA    | Comes into this race facing a harder field on the back of her first win at Grafton last start. Place best.  |

**R9 - CANTERBURY | 15:15 | AUD \$50,000 | SKY RACING ACTIVE MDN HCP**

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| <b>2</b> | CHARLES SEVEN  | Performing well since debut placing three races from five starts and could be up to running a big race here.  |
| <b>7</b> | SAIGON         | Five start maiden who was among the placegetters last start, finishing third over 1550m at this track. Rates highly on best form though and is among the better hopes.        |
| <b>1</b> | IMPACTFUL      | Open to much improvement after a fair debut when fourth over 1400m at Randwick Kensington. Shows ability and looks hard to beat.  |
| <b>4</b> | DANCING GIDGET | Been close at both her two starts in this time. Ready to improve now and should be able to find a good run from inside barrier. Strong chance.                                |
| <b>5</b> | LA TIGRESA     | Has been close up in recent runs including a last start second over 1400m at Kembla Grange when only a neck from the winner. Has the ability and is a definite each way hope. |

**R10 - MOONEE VALLEY | 15:30 | AUD \$60,000 | LADBROKES BACK YOURSELF-RS0MW**

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| <b>7</b> | STORMBORN        | Raced well on debut, but then didn't quite measure up the following start when fifth over 1000m at this track. Rates strongest on recent form and worthy of consideration here. |
| <b>3</b> | MASSEUSE         | Unraced filly by Rubick out of Ahhhh. Was a AUD \$ 150,000 (Inglis 2019 Melbourne Premier Yearling Sale) purchase. Yet to trial publicly. Keep a close eye on betting moves.    |
| <b>2</b> | HARD ROCK GIRL   | Resumes after three months off. Didn't impress in debut preparation. Well suited here. Should prove hard to beat.   |
| <b>1</b> | DIFFICULT        | Resumes after five months off. Debut run wasn't inspiring. Expect improvement on recent efforts. Keep safe.   |
| <b>5</b> | PLUCKY PIROUETTE | Made steady improvement at second career start, boxing on strongly to finish second over 1100m at Geelong. Thereabouts and can feature on best form.                            |

**R11 - CANTERBURY | 15:45 | AUD \$50,000 | HYLAND RACE COLOURS (BM70)**

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| <b>5</b> | NIMALEE     | Galloper with a good career winning two races three runs, last start finishing first over 1600m at Warwick Farm. Rates highly and expected to go close.              |
| <b>4</b> | GLAMOUR FOX | Good effort when third at Warwick Farm over 1400m last start. Has claims in this race if she can reproduce that form today. One of the main contenders.              |
| <b>2</b> | THE PROMISE | Disappointed last time when well beaten to finish seventh beaten by 6.25 lengths over 1600m at Warwick Farm. Can improve sharply.                                    |
| <b>3</b> | SELES       | Made a strong run to finish seventh over 1550m at this track and will relish the extra ground here. Looks well placed here and is worth including among the chances. |
| <b>6</b> | TEREKA      | Should be ready to improve after two runs back, the latest when fifth over 1300m at Kembla Grange. Not far away latest and can place with further improvement.       |

**R12 - MOONEE VALLEY | 16:00 | AUD \$60,000 | HAPPY VALENTINES T GREANEY MDN**

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| <b>9</b>  | HOLSTER        | Solid effort last start showing good ability. Up in the weights now but still appeals as well treated and should take plenty from that run. Genuine chance.                   |
| <b>7</b>  | CATEGORY FIVE  | Three-year-old colt who has been thereabouts at the finish at each of his career runs to date. One of the favourites here.  |
| <b>10</b> | FIFTYONESTATES | Remains a maiden after thirteen career runs but last time hit the frame, finishing second over 1600m at Pakenham Park. Expected to measure up.                                |
| <b>6</b>  | ALCIDES        | Kicked off latest campaign well at Geelong when third on January 26 over 1400m. Improved by first up run. Top chance.   |
| <b>11</b> | LOOK SHARPISH  | Was prominent throughout at Kyneton, working to the line in good fashion to run second. Wasn't far off the winner there. Looks capable of fighting out the finish again here. |

**R13 - CANTERBURY | 16:15 | AUD \$50,000 | MIRVAC (BM70)**

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| <b>2</b> | SEENTOOMANY        | Honest galloper who returned from a spell with a long neck win over 1300m at Sunshine Coast. Fitter and should be right in this.   |
| <b>5</b> | MAJELLA            | Resuming today after a successful first preparation winning two from four starts. Rates highly today.  |
| <b>1</b> | AIM FOR PERFECTION | Has been out of form this prep, last start she ran in ninth by 19 lengths at Warwick Farm. At peak now, can turn it around.  |
| <b>4</b> | ACCOY              | Resumes after a three months break when going to the paddock a winner after scoring over 1600m at Kembla Grange. Form good for this and fresh up here can break through if finds best. |
| <b>3</b> | TATIARA            | Resumed at Randwick Kensington over 1000m and missed the frame, finishing fifth and beaten 4.5 lengths. Should strip much fitter and rates among the chances on best form.             |

**R14 - MOONEE VALLEY | 16:30 | AUD \$60,000 | HAPPY VALENTINES (BM64)**

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| <b>7</b> | LEALE           | Improved on first up run and has won her last two and looking for a hat-trick. Facing tougher opposition here but she has been winning with something left in the tank. Could be too good for these again. |
| <b>1</b> | CASSIUS         | Progressive and lightly raced gelding. Last time recorded a 2.5 lengths fourth over 1600m at Caulfield. Rates highly in this and expected to be in the finish.   |
| <b>2</b> | HI STRANGER     | Lightly raced gelding progressing well. Last start posted a 2.75 lengths sixth over 1600m at Caulfield. Rates highly in this and expected to go close.   |
| <b>6</b> | SEAFIELD ROAD   | Found maiden win last start at Sandown-Lakeside. This is harder but has potential to improve. Consider for the place.  |
| <b>4</b> | FIELD OF LIGHTS | Broke through at Pakenham Park for his maiden win over 1600m last start and coming into a harder field this start. Place best.   |

**R15 - CANTERBURY | 16:45 | AUD \$50,000 | THE AGENCY REAL ESTATE (BM70)**

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| <b>4</b> | FABRICATOR      | Doesn't win out of turn but has found four wins and eleven minors from twenty eight starts. Could find a win looking well suited.                           |
| <b>5</b> | PEACE OF MIND   | Winner two starts back at Gosford which was followed up with a close second at Kembla Grange. Current form suggests will be competitive here.               |
| <b>2</b> | MOUNTAIN BREATH | Fitter for two runs back, the latest when 1.5 lengths third over 1800m at Randwick Kensington. Rates well here and looks suited here                        |
| <b>8</b> | TRYING          | Has not been far away in recent times and was a last start winner at Canberra. Expect bold showing.   |
| <b>7</b> | BEDIVERE        | Yet to recapture best form after two runs from a break, the latest finishing fourth over 1500m at Kembla Grange. Has the ability and shouldn't be far away. |

**R16 - MOONEE VALLEY | 17:00 | AUD \$60,000 | HAPPY VALENTINES K SUMMER-BM64**

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| <b>8</b> | VALLAURIS      | No longer a maiden after a win at Sale over 2200m last start, facing a rise in class this race. Can continue form this start.   |
| <b>1</b> | JUST A JOKE    | Winner of both starts this time in and looking for a hat-trick. This is a tougher race here but he has been winning with something in hand. Can't knock that winning form.  |
| <b>9</b> | PRES DE TOI    | Racing well and should be around the mark in this.  |
| <b>2</b> | SCHWEINSTEIGER | Shooting for a hat-trick of wins after making it two on end with half a length win over 1600m at Stony Creek. Going well and looks one of the leading chances.  |
| <b>7</b> | SHOCKINGLY     | Solid in both runs at the start of this preparation and then relished getting out to the mile last start when winning at Pakenham Park. Fitter again and will appreciate the extra trip but this will be tougher. Place best. |

**R17 - CANTERBURY | 17:15 | AUD \$50,000 | TAB (BM70)**

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| <b>4</b>  | THINK IT OVER  | Returned from a spell last start when second beaten only a neck at Warwick Farm on January 27 over 1400m. Should be well in the hunt when jumping from barrier three here. One of the main chances. |
| <b>2</b>  | ZEPPELIN       | Handy gelding who is a five time winner, the latest racing close to the speed and breaking through over 1550m. In winning form and can feature again.   |
| <b>11</b> | ZIDANE         | Fitter for recent racing and looks close to a win after finishing fourth over 1550m at this track last time. Racing well and expected to go close again.  |
| <b>5</b>  | ISLAND MISSILE | Finished midfield but beaten only 2.25 lengths when fifth over 1400m at Warwick Farm. Racing well and is worth including in the multiples.  |
| <b>6</b>  | OFF SHAW       | Has been running well this campaign but didn't measure up well last start finishing sixth at Warwick Farm. In the mix here.   |

**R18 - MOONEE VALLEY | 17:30 | AUD \$60,000 | LADBROKES 55SEC CHALLENGE-BM84**

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| <b>10</b> | SEI STELLA   | Returned with a good run when a long neck win over 955m at this track. Consistent overall record. Rates highly and expected to run well.                                   |
| <b>13</b> | DIRTY WORK   | Recorded a strong win at Randwick Kensington to break maiden status prior to going for a spell. Resumes after three months break. Main contender.                          |
| <b>5</b>  | MISS NORWAY  | Five-year-old mare who has a liking for this distance with multiple wins at this journey. Rates strongly and expected to finish much closer.                               |
| <b>11</b> | MISTER MOGUL | Going well lately, the latest 2.25 lengths win over 1000m at this track. Honest type with four wins to his name already. Has ability and looks one of the leading chances. |
| <b>2</b>  | EPIC GREY    | Nicely rated gelding. Scored a close win last start at Werribee winning by a nose starting at \$4.30. Major player.  |

**R19 - CANTERBURY | 17:45 | AUD \$50,000 | BISLEY WORKWEAR (BM72)**

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| <b>5</b> | DEFERENCE      | Progressive and lightly raced gelding. Last time recorded a 2 length third over 1000m at Warwick Farm. Rates highly in this and expected to go close. |
| <b>2</b> | GENERAL SOHO   | Missed the placings last time over a longer trip when fifth over 1250m at this track. Rates well and expected to go close.                            |
| <b>1</b> | SIR ELTON      | Was solid when resuming at Randwick. Had excuses for his fifth beaten 1.6 lengths. Looms as a significant threat here.                                |
| <b>6</b> | INTREPIDACIOUS | Returned in good order when second beaten only a head last start at this track over 1100m. Looks hard to beat after first up effort.                  |
| <b>7</b> | MONTE DITTO    | Lightly raced entire progressing well. Last start posted a 0.9 lengths fifth over 1100m at this track. Has the ability and can run a forward race.    |
