RACE 1: WELCOME TO FLEMINGATE LADIES DAY MAIDEN AUCTION STAKES

Kendred Soul Second Love Reviette

KENDRED SOUL was headed on the line at Catterick after making a significant move from a wide draw and attempting to make the running. The drop to a stiff 5f appears to be in her favour so Jedd O'Keeffe's filly could feasibly get off the mark at the fourth attempt. Second Love has placed on both outings to date and is likely to finish in the mix along with Reviette, who displayed a fair amount of promise when fourth over C&D on debut.

FLYLIKEANEAGLE ran well to finish second to a rival with more experience at Newcastle last month and the son of Free Eagle is likely to serve it up to his rivals on the front end. Yoshimi was best of the remainder behind an odds-on shot at York on his first outing and is entitled to be competitive on that display, while Kumasi, a half-brother to Lake Volta, and Wise Glory appeal most of the newcomers.
