# RACE 1: BETWAY BRITISH STALLION STUDS EBF NOVICE STAKES

Local Law Megallan Bazaari

Bazaari shaped encouragingly when runner-up on his debut over 7f at Lingfield but a couple of those in behind that day have let the form down since, while Top Brass and Impulsive One both ran well enough first time out to suggest that they could be competitive. However, the experienced runners don't set a daunting standard so it could be a couple of newcomers that fight out the finish. Megallan is certainly bred to have plenty of ability, with his 1m2f Listed-winning dam a half-sister to the top-class Golden Horn, and he warrants respect, but LOCAL LAW gets the vote for a stable that do particularly well in this type of event. He is a half-brother to multiple winners, including dual Group 2 scorer Loxley, and is likely to know his job on debut.

There are a number of interesting newcomers in this line-up representing powerful connections, Keep Right On, Uss Nimitz and Oracle Of Omaha to name a few, but it could pay to side with the experience of OLYMPIC THEATRE. He has shaped encouragingly in both starts to date over 6f, including when third here on debut, and stepping up in distance will do him no harm whatsoever. He was sent off 6/4 favourite when runner-up at Windsor last time, suggesting that connections think a fair bit of him, and it might be a case of third-time lucky for Michael Bell's son of Mayson.

BOSS POWER left his three performances in novice company well behind when scoring readily on his handicap debut over an extended 1m3f at Yarmouth last time. He was rock solid in the betting market that day, suggesting that the victory was no surprise to connections, and he is likely to improve again for this extra yardage, so gets the vote to defy a 7lb hike. Night Bear is another colt on the upgrade and only found subsequent winner Revolver too good at Haydock latest. He has a further 4lb rise to contend with but should run well, while Zuba is unlikely to be far away either.

Broughtons Gold stayed on well to score at Windsor on his latest outing and has to enter the reckoning, having won his sole outing over this trip at Kempton last October, while Black Caspian's recent York efforts give him every chance.
