DARK SHOT shaped encouragingly when second on his reappearance at Epsom and, although the assessor has since raised him 4lb, he's still rated 2lb lower than when finishing a neck second in this contest last year. Abel Handy returned to winning ways at Musselburgh and remains well treated on his classy juvenile form, while the improving Cowboy Soldier and consistent course-and-distance winner Copper Knight are others to note.

Her most impressive performance to date arguably came in Listed company over the extended 1m3f at this venue last August and the form of her two subsequent placed efforts in Group 1 company is rock solid. Nyaleti could be allowed to dictate matters from the front, thus making her a dangerous player, while Rawdaa looks sure to appreciate stepping back up from a mile.

Line Of Duty is another who could go well, while Telecaster should not be underestimated despite having only won a novice stakes event.
