> Time For War gelding who was a \$5000 yearling. Last trial ran 3rd at Scone barrier trial over 4 1/2f on February 14. Expected to measure up here.

Five-year-old gelding who has a liking for this distance with multiple wins at this journey. Thereabouts last time and rates well here.

Talented mare caught the eye last start when winning in easier company at Forbes. She goes well at this distance, and will handle the class jump here. Another win likely.

Made all last start and came away with a win at this track over 4 1/2f on January 20. Multiple winner over this distance. Proven to be race fit.

- Missed the placings last time over a longer trip when sixth over 6 1/2f at Dubbo. Rates well and JOEY'S CHANCE gets chance to break through.
 - Five-year-old fresh off a 272-day break. Yet to miss a minor placing in two resuming runs. Trialled prior to this and looks set for another bold first-up showing.
 - Back from a eight months spell following 7.25 lengths sixth over 6 1/2f at Scone. Rates highly here and expected to run well.

Was underwhelming last start but if he can replicate the form of his third place run Taree two back he could give hope to this run. Well held latest and prefer the place.
