Arecibo Final Venture Justanotherbottle

Dakota Gold took apart a competitive Great St Wilfrid field at Ripon on Saturday, but that success came with softer underfoot conditions and despite having won on good to firm earlier in his career, he will need to replicate that effort on a sounder surface. With that in mind, preference is for ARECIBO as he was drawn away from the action in the Stewards' Cup and boasts a progressive profile. Final Venture, Justanotherbottle and Gunmetal are others to consider.

His stablemate Circus Maximus beat King Of Comedy in the St James's Palace and is proven over this trip too, although John Gosden's colt is bred to relish 1m2f and has been aimed at this since Ascot.
