AUSTRALIA - 22nd November 2019

R1 - ORANGE | 12:45 | AUD \$22,000 | TLE & HOMETECH ORANGE HCP-C3

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| 4 | TIME OF GLORY | Dual acceptor. Kicked off latest campaign nicely at Kembla Grange when runner up on October 26 over 1200m. Will be suited by the rails run. Winning chance. |
| 3 | NINES ENOUGH | Dual acceptor. |
| 5 | SPEED CAMERA | Tends to mix her results a bit although first visit to this track last start yielded a win. Timeform ratings indicate that further improvement is on the cards. |
| 1 | PLAYARD | Very good win off a break at Wyong. Won previously second up and appears capable of building on that record here on the back of latest performance. Far easier here, leading hope. |
| 2 | HIGHLY DESIRED | Dual acceptor. Five-year-old gelding back in action today. Unsited to this short trip. Can't enthuse. |

R2 - GOSFORD | 13:00 | AUD \$35,000 | DOVMAC MINING AND CONSTR.-BM64

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| 1 | CONTINUATION | Has been close up in recent runs including a last start fourth over 1800m at Randwick-Kensington when only 2 lengths from the winner. Has the ability and looks one of the major players. |
| 6 | HEMSTED | Not disgraced in small fields of late and racing very genuinely at present. Last start ran third when well supported at Hawkesbury over 2000m. Good chance on best. |
| 5 | TYRRHENIAN | No longer a maiden after a win at Wyong over 2100m last start, facing a rise in class this race. Place best. |
| 2 | BELLS 'N' BOWS | In form runner who brought up a hat-trick of wins with success over this trip last start. In top form and expected to go close again. |
| 4 | THE KROC | Won by a comfortable margin last start in easier company at Kempsey. This talented gelding goes well at this distance, and will handle the class jump here. Improving type. Place best. |

R3 - ORANGE | 13:20 | AUD \$22,000 | DVM EMBROIDERY MDN HCP

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| 3 | EMPOWERED MADAM | Yet to break through in nine runs but wasn't far away last time at second over 1400m at Dubbo on November 2. Went close last time and should be in the finish. |
| 2 | ARTIE'S ROSE | Improved twice over to place second at Queanbeyan last time out over 1460m. Looks well placed and rates highly off that run. Expected in the finish. |
| 5 | BANSURI | Tends to mix her form but improved last start finishing third over 1600m. Can keep going on with it. |
| 7 | MOWANJUM | Fair effort when fourth at this track last start and has to have claims if she can run up to that form again. Third up now and comes in well here. |
| 8 | RHYTHMO | Had the blinkers added last time over 1300m at Bathurst to finish a 4 length. Close to a win. One of the chances. |

R4 - GOSFORD | 13:35 | AUD \$35,000 | CENTRAL COAST MARINERS HCP-C2

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| 4 | LAGARDE | Was solid when resuming at Hawkesbury. Had excuses for her fifth beaten 2.25 lengths. Looms as a significant threat here. |
| 5 | ZETA'S ROCKET | Found himself positioned up on the speed at Wyong last start and worked home nicely, running second. Wasn't beaten by far in that affair. Warrants some consideration after latest effort. |
| 2 | LIBERTY SUN | Won his debut run handily at this track over 1000m before going for a spell. Each way chance. |
| 3 | SIEGE WARFARE | Five-year-old gelding who races well over this distance and goes well with multiple strong performances. Not far away but prefer each way. |
| 7 | DIZZY MISS LIZZY | Inconsistent type who improved last start finishing third over 1000m. Can contest today. |

R5 - ORANGE | 13:55 | AUD \$22,000 | BUCKLEY'S CARPET COURT HCP-C3

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| 3 | FIVE STAR GAL | Beaten by a half a length when second at Warren on 1600m in latest effort. Looks a good chance on that form. |
| 5 | BOULT | Scored last time at Warren and has a solid record at this journey. Well suited here. Should prove hard to beat. |
| 2 | DEFY | Scored latest over 1600m at Wagga and will carry less weight here. Last start winner and can measure up here. |
| 4 | CARINDA ROAD | Almost found the win last start running a close 0.8 lengths second at Dubbo over 1600m. In the mix coming into this start. |
| 1 | HOLY EMPRESS | Racing well below best this campaign, the latest when 6.5 lengths seventh over 1600m at Goulburn. Has minor claims. |

R6 - GOSFORD | 14:10 | AUD \$50,000 | SKY RACING B RUTLEDGE MEM.-C5

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| 7 | KING HEWITT | Good effort when third at Hawkesbury over 1600m last start as favourite. Has claims in this race if he can reproduce that form today. One of the main contenders. |
| 6 | CONDOR | Needs to bounce back after an underwhelming performance last start, if he can replicate the form of a third place run at this track two back then he can stack up today. Better than last start and can improve here. |
| 11 | KEDAH | Running well recently including a last start fourth by 3 lengths over 1300m at Randwick-Kensington. Has the ability and can break through on best form. |
| 1 | CULLINGWORTH | After some consistent form ran well below best last time when a 2.25 lengths eighth over 1600m at Eagle Farm. Has the ability and can bounce back. |
| 4 | SPIN BOWLES | Shooting for a hat-trick of wins after making it two on end with a head win over 1600m at Hawkesbury. Going well and is among the winning hopes. |

R7 - ALICE SPRINGS | 14:35 | AUD \$16,000 | LADBROKES BACK YOURSELF HCP-58

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| 4 | DELIGHTFUL SPIRIT | Hit and miss galloper who ran well below best last time when a 7 length fourth over 1200m at this track. Has the ability and can bounce back here. |
| 1 | BRAZILLIANT | Course and distance winner who is overdue for a win, the latest when sixth but beaten only 5.25 lengths over 1200m at this track. Thereabouts lately and expected to go close. |
| 7 | HARRY HELLRAISER | Missed the placings last time over a longer trip when fourth over 1200m at this track. Can make a bold showing and can sneak into the finish with the right run. |
| 3 | TIGER TRAP | Needs to bounce back after an underwhelming performance last start, if he can replicate the form of a second place run at Kununurra two back then he can stack up today. Will be doing best work late. |
| 2 | THE STAR LEGEND | Resumes today after scoring his maiden win two back in his debut campaign. Rates poorly, happy to overlook. |

R8 - ALICE SPRINGS | 15:15 | AUD \$16,000 | ELDERS INSURANCE HCP (58)

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| 1 | RAWTEKK | Resumes today after scoring his maiden win four back in his debut campaign. Rates highly today. |
| 6 | SHOAL RIVER | Doesn't win often and last win was well over a year ago. Latest when a 5.5 lengths sixth over 1400m at this track. Has the ability and can run a forward race. |
| 4 | GRANDE CASTAGNO | Veteran well held last couple, the latest finishing ninth and beaten 14 lengths over 1000m at this track. Has the ability and is a definite each way hope. |
| 2 | LISA | Ran a fair result two back at this circuit and distance, running fourth by 2.5 lengths. Rates for a place. |
| 7 | REDWOOD GARDENS | Returns from four months after finishing eighth over 1400m at this track before a break, looking to others today. |

R9 - MOONEE VALLEY | 15:30 | AUD \$50,000 | 3 POINT MOTORS PLATE

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| 4 | SAYL | Yet to break through in ten runs but wasn't far away last time at second over 1600m at this track on November 1. Close to a win and gets chance to break through. |
| 7 | KUSARI | Placed one of two career runs, and looks close to break through following a nose second over 1400m at Pakenham Park. Has upside and rates among the leading chances. |
| 9 | MISS POLANSKI | Produced some good performances recently, most recently third at Cranbourne. Rises in journey. Should finish off strongly. |
| 2 | HIGH HOPES | Claims the highest peak Timeform rating of the field. Finished a close second at Moe over 1628m as favourite last start. Well drawn. Main contender. |
| 11 | TINSZEL | Still a maiden after finishing seventh over 1600m at Ballarat last time out and draws low here. Best efforts give her a chance and could sneak into the finish. |

R10 - ALICE SPRINGS | 15:45 | AUD \$17,000 | HYGAIN HCP (70)

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| 4 | RAZOR TIME | Had a winning run broken last time out when second at this track. Rates well and is down in weight today. |
| 1 | HEART OF RED | Consistent gelding who was well below best last time when seventh over 1400m at this track. Rarely far away and can find best here. |
| 5 | THE MAILMAN | Missed the placings last time over a longer journey when fifth over 1200m at this track. Rates well and looks hard to beat. |
| 2 | BABE IN BOOTS | Six-year-old resuming on her home track. Handy first-up record and finished last campaign in reasonable form. Could be in the mix. |
| 3 | NIC NAC | Seven-year-old local galloper resuming. Handy fresh record and finished last campaign in reasonable form. Not the roughest here. |

R11 - MOONEE VALLEY | 16:00 | AUD \$50,000 | \$99 SUMMER MEMBERSHIP (BM64)

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| 6 | HEKA EXPRESS | Powered home to win with style by 5 lengths at Ballarat last start, rises in class this start. Rates well despite tougher race. |
| 2 | COVERT MISS | Going well lately, the latest 6 lengths win over 1100m at Warrnambool. Honest type with three wins to her name already. Rates highly here and is right in the mix again. |
| 7 | NICCONI PONI | Finished midfield but beaten only 2.5 lengths when sixth over 1100m at Randwick-Kensington. Has the ability and is expected to run well again. |
| 8 | INFERNAL | Returned to the winners circle after a long while last time out at Pakenham Park scoring by 1.8 lengths. 2kg apprentice claim helps. |
| 4 | UNICORNY | Four-year-old mare who won last time at this distance, winning by a long neck at this track. Last start winner at this trip and looks one of the chances. |

R12 - SUNSHINE COAST | 16:15 | AUD \$21,000 | TURTLE BEACH RESORT MDN HCP

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| 15 | FLATTER | Will be fitter second up after a strong debut run at Gold Coast. Should excel in this. |
| 11 | NALSSENDORI | Beaten by a neck when second at Gold Coast on 1200m in latest effort. Looks close to a win here. |
| 6 | FRENCH OCEAN | Been close at both his two starts in this time. Ready to improve now. Strong chance. |
| 1 | THERENBACK | Showed potential first campaign and has a placing at this track. Ran second in his latest trial over 1000 at Doomben on November 4. Strong chance here. |
| 2 | GLAM ROCK | Performing well since debut placing three races from six starts and could find the frame this start. |

R13 - MOONEE VALLEY | 16:30 | AUD \$50,000 | MLA HOLDINGS (BM70)

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| 4 | SOVEREIGN AWARD | Been thereabouts in both campaign starts. Chased solidly during latest when sixth at Flemington. Ready to improve now. Strong chance. |
| 2 | BRIMM | Improved twice over to place second at Bendigo last time out over 1600m. Looks well placed and rates highly off that run. Can do one better here. |
| 3 | ESPOSITO GOLD | Struggling for form this campaign, the latest when 1.4 lengths fourth over 1500m at Mornington. Looks well suited, definite claims. |
| 5 | TATA DA GOOSE | Resumed from a break when finishing fifth over 1400m at Cranbourne. Rates among the hopes and is worth including in calculations. |
| 6 | MUSIC OF THE NIGHT | First-up here. Doesn't usually fire early on and tends to do her best work a bit later. Place looks her best hope. |

R14 - SUNSHINE COAST | 16:45 | AUD \$30,000 | GUIDE DOGS QUEENSLAND HCP (C4)

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| 8 | THE PINES | Four-year-old mare who kept her record at the course intact when scoring by one length over 1200m here last time. Going well and on strong record at this course rates a leading playing again. |
| 9 | LET'S GO BOBBY | Fitter and does have a solid second up record. Resumed with a head win over 1000m at this track. Rates strongly and expected to have come on. |
| 7 | KITTY DAMOUR | Resumed in pretty good fashion at Eagle Farm and wasn't too far off despite finishing fifth. She tends to run well second-up and must be considered a threat in this line-up. |
| 1 | PURE PULSE | Has been thereabouts without winning, the latest finishing second over 1200m at Gold Coast. Has the ability and is a definite each way hope. |
| 12 | VENETIAN BEAUTY | Won barrier trial on November 12 and resumes here after 200 day break. Multiple first-up winner previously. Should be thereabouts at the finish if forward enough. |

R15 - MOONEE VALLEY | 17:00 | AUD \$50,000 | K LINE GROUP (BM64)

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| 5 | LIVING THE DREAM | Progressive and lightly raced entire. Last time recorded a 3 length third over 1600m at Bendigo. Has the ability and looks one of the major players. |
| 3 | NICAJON | Improved twice over to place second at this track last time out over 1600m. Looks well placed and rates highly off that run. Top chance. |
| 1 | GASWORX | Almost found the win last start running a close a head second at Kyneton over 1450m. Looks close to a win here. |
| 2 | FRANKLY HARVEY | This preparation only missed the place once. Last start second at Cranbourne when in the market. Impressed last start. Right in the mix again. |
| 6 | BUFFALO BILL | Progressive and lightly raced gelding. Last time recorded a 3.25 lengths fifth over 1400m at Ballarat. Has the ability and is a definite each way hope. |

R16 - SUNSHINE COAST | 17:15 | AUD \$21,000 | CLAYTON'S TOWING SERVICE MDN

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| 6 | CONSTRUE | Still a maiden but managed to finish within a length of the winner last time out when second over 1800m at Gold Coast. Should be right in the mix. |
| 1 | ACEME | Running well recently including a last start second by 0.8 lengths over 1600m at this track. Thereabouts lately and expected to run well. |
| 5 | BEST FOOT FORWARD | Drops in distance since latest effort at this track when fourth, finishing 3 lengths off the winner. Can be thereabouts at the finish. |
| 8 | INCREDIBELLE | Has run home well in both career starts suggesting the step up to 1800m here will be right up her gate. Watch for her rattling home once again. |
| 10 | PEERLESS CRUISE | Eight start maiden ran second last start being beaten by 2.25 lengths over 1600m at Gatton. Can do better here and shouldn't be far away. |

R17 - MOONEE VALLEY | 17:30 | AUD \$55,000 | LADBROKES 55SEC CHALLENGE-BM84

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| 5 | WRITTEN CHOICE | Five-year-old gelding who finished tenth and beaten 4.75 lengths over 1100m at Flemington last time. Rates strongly and on top record here expected to run well. |
| 6 | PROPELLE | Likes the trip and races well with a number of performances that would put her into contention in today's race. Rates strongly and expected to finish much closer. |
| 7 | REBEL MISS | Returned to the winners circle after a long while last time out at this track scoring by a head. Gets a chance to win again. Take seriously. |
| 1 | OUR LUCA | Given a break following a below par run when tenth, beaten 17 lengths over 1000m at Sandown-Hillside. Ran below best latest but can do better this time. |
| 4 | BOLD STAR | First-up here. Doesn't usually fire early on and tends to do his best work a bit later. Place looks his best hope. |

R18 - SUNSHINE COAST | 17:45 | AUD \$21,000 | LALLEMAND ANIMAL NUTRITION-C2

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| 5 | ELLEOFADEEL | Solid in both runs at the start of this preparation and then relished getting out to 1800m last start when winning at Gold Coast. Fitter again so expect further improvement. |
| 1 | TRAINSPOTTING | Lightly raced gelding progressing well. Last start posted a one length second over 1800m at Gold Coast. Has the ability and looks one of the chances. |
| 8 | NYMERIA | Scored maiden win over 1350m two back then out of the placings last time at Eagle Farm when fifth. Has ability and expected to do much better. |
| 6 | TAINTED AFFAIR | Solid in both runs at the start of this preparation and then relished getting out to the mile last start when winning at Gatton. Fitter again so consider each way. |
| 7 | NOM DE THEATRE | Ran on strongly and found a maiden win at this track last time out. This is harder but has potential to improve. Place best. |

R19 - MOONEE VALLEY | 18:00 | AUD \$50,000 | RANVET HCP (C1)

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| 4 | GRAND SCHOLAR | Strong effort last start to win by 3.5 lengths at Cranbourne, rising in class today. Looks well suited among this field. |
| 1 | SANTORINI SUMMER | Lightly raced gelding progressing well. Last start posted a 10 length 14th over 1000m at Flemington. Has the ability and expected to run well. |
| 3 | THE EXECUTIONER | Out of the placings last time when ninth over a longer 1400m journey at Caulfield. Can improve on last start and expected to be in the finish. |
| 9 | ROLLS | Lightly raced gelding progressing well. Last start posted a 4 length win over 1200m at Hamilton. Has the ability and looks one of the chances. |
| 6 | GARBO | Broke through at Warrnambool for his maiden win over 1100m last start and coming into a harder field this start. Place best. |

R20 - SUNSHINE COAST | 18:15 | AUD \$21,000 | BEERWAH HIDEAWAY HCP (C1)

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| 1 | GIN 'N' BITTERS | Made a pleasing start to her career, scoring a debut win at this track. Sets the standard here |
| 8 | HONEY BABY | Found maiden win last start at Toowoomba. Rates well and can continue winning form. In the mix on best form. |
| 2 | QUEEN OF THE NIGHT | Made a pleasing start to her career, scoring a debut win at Gold Coast. Sets the standard here |
| 5 | MAGIC DESERT MOON | Returned in good order when third beaten only a long neck last start at Gold Coast over 900m. Others preferred. |
| 6 | STAGE PLAY | Honest galloper who returned from a spell as favourite with half a length win over 1000m at this track. Up in weight but rates among the chances. |
