Subutai is a half-brother to Angel's Hideaway, who won a Group 3 as a two-year-old last season, and he is arguably the pick of the newcomers, ahead of Wild Thunder and Buhturi.**

Lightening Dance and White Chocolate both have winning course form to their name over 1m2f and can show up well for a long way, though the main danger may be Hulcote, a staying-on third over 1m2f at Doncaster in March.**
