Mark Johnston saddled the winner of this contest 12 months ago and appears to have another cracking chance with DARK VISION this time around. The four-year-old came desperately close to following up his Royal Hunt Cup success in the Coral Challenge at Sandown 18 days ago and the stiff finish here should suit this strong stayer. Beringer lacks a recent run but his latest second behind subsequent Group 1 winner Lord North is rock solid form. He and Oh This Is Us, who wasn't beaten far in this grade at Epsom last time, look to be the main dangers.
