- Powered home to win with style by 5.5 lengths at Toowoomba last start, rises in class this start. **TALAPUS**
 - Keeps improving with each run this campaign. Still seems to have further improvement left in him after a good last start run at Ipswich. Strong hope.
 - Beaten by a neck when second at Ipswich on 2180m in latest effort. An each way option for this start.
 - Five-year-old mare proven in easier company but hasn't managed a win in the city from 5 starts. Place looks best chance in this.

- Dual acceptor. Well rated gelding who ran a close second last start at Randwick-Kensington **TRUMBULL** when beaten a head after starting at \$7.50. Should be right there in the finish.
- Handy sort with two wins from six runs, scoring last time over 1200m at Gosford. Form good for **JETSKI** this and looks one of the major hopes.
 - Winner two starts back at Canterbury which was followed up with a close third at this track. Must come into consideration on current form.
 - Finished midfield but beaten only 1.2 lengths when third over 1200m at Moonee Valley. Racing well and is worth including in the multiples.
 - Resumed from a spell with a third before a disappointing seventh at this track last start. Must improve on last display to figure in this event.
