1. KENWAY - Runner up on debut at Saint-Cloud last month and a huge chance here on that form

- 2. HAS D'EMRA Fourth on debut in a Saint-Cloud claimer last month but will need more here
- 3. PIXY DREAM Finished fifth and last on debut here earlier in the month so needs to show a lot more
- 4. LOVE VEGA Runner up on debut here earlier this month and will be taking a hand in finish here too
- 5. WHEELS ON FIRE A newcomer by Sidestep. Dam was poor unplaced maiden. This is her first foal to race here today
- 6. ALTA ROCCA By Rip De La Plata. Mother was unplaced average maiden. This is her first produce to hit the racetrack
- 7. FRENCHY By French Navy. Mother was unraced and this is her first foal to come racing

Summary

This two year old maiden race looks an absolute formality for (1) KENWAY. The wise old backers used always say that when a debutant locks horns with another rival and they pull more than three lengths of the third then they should never be opposed in their next start. Therefore, the selection cannot be opposed after doing just that when a neck second at Saint-Cloud last month and the first two were clear. (4) LOVE VEGA ought to be runner up in front of (5) WHEELS ON FIRE and (6) ALTA ROCCA.

- 1. BALRANALD Much improved off debut when scoring at Cagnes-sur-Mer in January. Fifth next time before solid second at Toulouse last time. Big step up in trip
- 2. GROUP DEUX CREUX Started racing in November. One win from four starts and never out of the frame. Runner up in last two. Every chance
- 3. SKAZINO Won on debut last November but unplaced in three runs since. Has a bit to find with the favourites
- 4. ANIEL Off the mark on the last of her three starts when just getting the job done at Mont-de-Marsan. This is harder
- 5. GINGER DES CHAMPS All three runs have come this season and at Lyon-La-Soie. Steady improvement each time culminating with a win there last time. More to come
- 6. TARASIF Just the one run and finished sixth here earlier this month shaping adequately enough. Needs to improve
- 7. CAPE PEARL Won on debut at Nimes in February before a close second at Marseille-Vivaux last time out in March. Chance
- 8. HANIDA Just got up on debut to win at Agen last month. Plenty to like about that effort and sure to be involved at the business end

Summary

Many of these are taking a big step up in trip but the one that is not is (8) HANIDA who made a winning debut at Angers last month where she just got the better of a very well bred fancied sort from a powerful yard and there is no reason at all why she will not improve from that. She quickened well when attacked late on and this extra yardage is perfect. (5) GINGER DES CHAMPS and (2) GROUP DEUX CREUX look next best in front of (7) CAPE PEARL.

- 1. CARTER AND GO Both wins from eight came in his last two runs at Marseille-Vivaux and every chance

- 3. KAYZEN Placed in all four outings and just denied by The Live Freedom at Salon Provence last time
- 4. ZIGLIARA Placed in two of her half dozen starts and will need to eek out some more improvement
- 5. ON THE EDGE A three time winner from fourteen runs. Fourth at Salon Provence last time out. More exposed than others
- 6. MOULT One success from seven outings. Running to a similar level most of the time. Must find more
- 7. ARROZ Won on debut last September at Divonne. Three runs since and third at Salon Provence last time earlier this month
- 8. PETIT SAM Sole success from eighteen came at Lyon-La-Soie in February. Very consistent and runner up at Salon Provence last time

Summary

A nice little three year old handicap here with (2) THE LIVE FREEDOM getting a pretty hopeful vote to confirm the form with (3) KAYZEN from their meeting at Salon Provence earlier this month. The selection made most of the running and won narrowly from today's rival but he had a little more in the tank and is totally unexposed. (1) CARTER AND GO and (8) PETIT SAM can place.

She is sure to do even better today and will have to to take care of the likes of (3) RICHEMONT who is certainly a threat. (2) ROSISSIM and (5) SALMANA have lesser hopes.
