

# TIP SHEET

MELBOURNE - 26th March 2020

## R1 - KILMORE | 12:30 | AUD \$22,000 | KILMORE TRACKSIDE (BM58)

2	BIG DARRYL	Talented gelding caught the eye last start when winning in easier company at Benalla. He goes well at this distance, and will handle the class jump here. Genuine improver. Hard to beat.
5	OURS	Resumes after a year break after finishing 99 over 2 m at Oakbank. Fitter for a trial run and should go close.
7	RIVAROLA	Latest ran in third over 7f at Benalla, rarely winning with just one success from 13 starts. Has the ability and expected to run well.
3	SHOCKINGLY	Broke through for maiden success over 1m two back at Pakenham Park then missed last time at Moonee Valley when seventh. Has ability and is among the winning hopes.
9	BOO DUP	Struggling for form this campaign, the latest when 3.25 lengths seventh over 6 1/2f at Geelong. Ratings suggest she has claims here.

## R2 - KILMORE | 13:00 | AUD \$22,000 | JET ROOFING (BM58)

5	ALEDA	Was solid when resuming at Flemington, although ninth was only beaten 2.75 lengths. Will appreciate the drop in grade here and looms as threat.
2	MAGNESIUM ROSE	Racing well and just needs even luck from a wide draw to be in the finish here.
4	BEDOUIIN KING	Back from a five months spell following 1.5 lengths fourth over 1 1/2m at Bendigo. Rates highly here and looks one of the leading chances.
9	MISS CARBONI	Is overdue for a win with three placings from five runs this campaign but did race a little below best last time when midfield at Stawell. Rates highly here and expected to go close.
1	ELMORE LAD	Yet to break through this campaign but hasn't been far away including a last start second over 6f at this track. Racing well and should prove hard to beat again.

## R3 - KILMORE | 13:30 | AUD \$22,000 | MC LABOUR (BM58)

7	IMPERIAL KING	Broke a drought when returning to winning form last start over 6f at Berrigan. Back in form and can go back to back.
2	WIND FORCE	Stepping out to this circuit for the first time but rates well at this journey. Not far away last time. In the mix again.
5	CARWELKIN	Battled last start to finish sixth at Kyneton. Can forget last start getting a chance here today.
1	BLUE VALOUR	Not disgraced when fourth two starts back but finished well off the pace last start at Corowa. Will find this race harder. Is capable on his day and is not out of it.
11	SLY SONG	Finished midfield but beaten only 2.5 lengths when fifth over 6 1/2f at Geelong. Rates highly here and should run well.

## R4 - KILMORE | 14:00 | AUD \$22,000 | BERALDO COFFEE (BM58)

3	COURT DEEP	Consistent galloper. Broke through for maiden win as favourite at Stawell last time out. Should be close to peak fitness. Winning chance here.
2	ROAR	Handy gelding racing in good form, finished midfield last time when fourth but beaten only 2.5 lengths over 7 1/4f. Racing well and expected to measure up.
7	GIVE VAL A RING	Last start sixth at Stawell when in the market and is stepping to 7 1/4f for the first time today. Rates highly and can do much better.
5	HARD FAITH	Has been well held in two runs since a win three back. Finished sixth and beaten 6.25 lengths at Pakenham Park last time. Rates highly in this field and may be worth another chance.
4	ISLAND DANCER	Started this campaign with poor form, last start recording fifth by 5.5 lengths over 7f at Pakenham Park. Easier here and rates well this company.

**R5 - PAKENHAM PARK | 14:30 | AUD \$35,000 | RACING.COM MDN PLATE**

<b>8</b>	SAYUMI	Has been a model of consistency this time in. Rises in trip. Has the scope to win here.
<b>5</b>	RESET ALL	Settled back but made a sustained run to find the frame over 7f at this track and will appreciate the extra ground here. Sure to go close if runs up to latest.
<b>3</b>	FEND OFF	Son of Shocking from the mare Princess Pedrille and was a \$25000 yearling. Last trial won barrier trial over 6f at Cambridge in November. Profiles well and worth keeping safe.
<b>1</b>	BUMRAH	Finished off last campaign with a 3.5 lengths fifth over 1m at Benalla. Fitter for a trial and looks an each way hope.
<b>7</b>	IF YOU LEAVE	Unraced filly by Iffraaj out of Dagmar. Yet to trial publicly. Pay to keep an eye on betting moves.

**R6 - PAKENHAM PARK | 15:00 | AUD \$35,000 | BACKCARE & SEATING MDN**

<b>3</b>	FAVELL	Could manage only midfield last time at Moonee Valley but has been going pretty well without winning, with placings at two of three runs this time in. Rates highly here and gets chance to bounce back.
<b>5</b>	MASTER BARTHOLDI	Won barrier trial at Benalla by a comfortable margin in preparation for this first race start. Colt by Statue Of Liberty. Expect strong showing in debut run.
<b>10</b>	KLATTEN	Rich Enuff filly who made an encouraging debut at \$7.50 when third over 6f at Kilmore. Rates well here and expected to prove hard to beat.
<b>8</b>	AUDACIOUS HEART	Daughter of Fastnet Rock from the mare More Valour making debut. Has the benefit of a trial hit-out and looks set for a strong run.
<b>6</b>	SURPRIZE EFFECT	Two-year-old gelding who makes his debut today. No trial form to work with and market should provide best guide.

**R7 - PAKENHAM PARK | 15:30 | AUD \$35,000 | DE BORTOLI WINES MDN**

<b>12</b>	VISTABELLE	Among the placings in her latest trial and bold showing expected. Kicks off race career today and worth keeping safe.
<b>11</b>	TIDEWAY	Unraced filly by Helmet out of Tramell. Not seen in a public trial to date. Take on trust from this strong stable.
<b>8</b>	IT'S TRUE	Three-year-old filly stepping out for her first race start. Untried, so tough to assess chances. Watch market.
<b>7</b>	DIHHI	Resumed over 5 1/2f and missed the placings when a 6 length eighth at Geelong. Rates highly and expected to finish much closer. Fitter for the run and expected to be in the finish this time.
<b>10</b>	ORBITING	Resumes after five months off. Didn't impress in only debut run. Rates an each way hope here.

**R8 - PAKENHAM PARK | 16:00 | AUD \$35,000 | R&C ASPHALT MDN**

<b>11</b>	THEE ONE	Consistent filly who has placed three times from three career starts. Should break though for that elusive maiden win here. Top rated.
<b>10</b>	GROOVY KINDA LOVE	Shows ability finishing in the money at both runs, the latest when second over 6 1/2f at Geelong. Close to a win and gets chance to break through.
<b>5</b>	SINGLE CROWN	Fair effort when second at Benalla last start when well supported and has to have claims if he can run up to that form again. Third up now and looks a strong winning chance.
<b>9</b>	GREAT AMBITION	Has not been far away in recent times finishing third at Yarra Valley two runs back which was followed by a second last start. Rises in distance for this and must come into consideration.
<b>1</b>	ALEXANDER HAMILTON	Finished midfield over 6 1/2f at Geelong last time, 4.25 lengths from the winner. Gets a little weight relief as he tackles a longer journey. Rates an each way hope here.

**R9 - PAKENHAM PARK | 16:30 | AUD \$35,000 | RED GEM PACKERS & GROWERS-BM70**

<b>4</b>	PAPERBOY	Sat on the speed a fortnight back at this track and fought on well to win. He has an excellent record at this venue and can easily do the job again.
<b>10</b>	STREET ICON	Looks overdue for another win on recent form including a last start second over 5f at Sandown-Hillside. Rates highly in this and expected to be in the finish.
<b>1</b>	TIGGER	Latest run was good when runner up at Cranbourne on March 6 over 6 1/2f. Gets slugged with 136lbs here. Won his last start at this track and distance thirteen starts ago. Rates a winning chance.
<b>7</b>	OPEN MINDED	Only just narrowly beaten when attempting to make all over 6 1/2f at Cranbourne last start. Each way chance.
<b>9</b>	ZAIDIN	Kept coming last time over 6f at Moonee Valley to finish fourth and will appreciate the extra ground here. Rates strongly here and capable of going close.

**R10 - PAKENHAM PARK | 17:00 | AUD \$35,000 | DROUIN/DISTRICT COMMUNITY-BM64**

<b>9</b>	HE'S THE REAL DEEL	Led all the way last start and came away with a win at this track over 6 1/2f on March 14. Rises in weight on that deserved win. Will be fitter for the outing.
<b>2</b>	ANALYTICA	Out of the placings last time when sixth over a longer 7f journey at Benalla. Rates well and gets chance to break through.
<b>1</b>	SIR HARALD	Won at long odds by 1.8 lengths two back when fresh at \$21.00 over 5 1/2f at Bendigo. Major player.
<b>5</b>	LORD LENNOX	Resumes after a nine months break after finishing 7 over 7 1/2f at Geelong. Fitter for a trial run and should be right in the mix.
<b>6</b>	BRONZE STAR	Resumed at Kilmore over 5 1/2f and missed the frame, finishing fourth and beaten 6.25 lengths. Should strip much fitter and expected to be in the mix this time.

**R11 - PAKENHAM PARK | 17:30 | AUD \$35,000 | JOHN DUFF & CO (BM70)**

<b>6</b>	CHARLEISE	Resumes in this after five months off. Has a good record resuming. Trialled leading up to this so fitness shouldn't be a query. Can take this.
<b>4</b>	TALENTED	Honest galloper who returned from a spell with a nose win over 6 1/2f at Sandown-Hillside. Fitter and looks hard to beat.
<b>2</b>	MISS LADYBIRD	Led from start to finish last start and came away with a win at this track over 6 1/2f on March 11. Was an outsider on that occasion and is sure to be higher up in the market here.
<b>3</b>	FUDGED	Out of the placings last time when eighth over a longer 1m journey at Sandown-Hillside. Rates fairly and shouldn't be far away.
<b>5</b>	ELEGANT SNITZ	Handy mare who broke through for a win over 7f at this track. Doesn't win out of turn and will need to go on with it.

**R12 - PAKENHAM PARK | 18:00 | AUD \$35,000 | SPORTSBET (BM64)**

<b>3</b>	CARPOOL KARAOKE	Won debut run by 1.3 lengths at this track over 7f, prior finished win in a Cranbourne trial on March 3. This tougher and longer but must be respected after that win.
<b>1</b>	STEINBRENNER	Out of the placings last time when fifth over a longer 1 1/8m journey at Sandown-Hillside. Can improve on last start and looks close on best form.
<b>2</b>	YANACOCHA	Progressive and lightly raced gelding. Last time recorded a neck win over 1m at Benalla. Rates highly in this and expected to be in the finish.
<b>7</b>	MILLIE THE MISSILE	Struggling to break through this campaign, the latest a fair 2.75 lengths fifth over 1m at Kilmore. Overdue for a win and shouldn't be far away.
<b>4</b>	RAKOVSKY	Was thereabouts last time finishing a 3.5 lengths fifth at Ballarat. Down a little in weight and stretches out in journey this time. Rates well and looks one of the chances.
