Chase The Dollar Ventura Mutiny Broxi

Broxi didn't offer much encouragement at Hamilton and needs to improve for the experience, as Ventura Mutiny did when third at Redcar. The bar isn't set very high and this looks an ideal opportunity for CHASE THE DOLLAR. Mark Johnston's Frankel colt is out of a mare who won the Rockfel at two, and won't need to live up to that illustrious pedigree fully to get off the mark.
