UNITED KINGDOM - 31st July 2020

R13 - PONTEFRACT | 19:25 | GBP £6,400 | BRITISH STALLION STUDS EBF MAIDEN STAKES (PLUS 10)

4	POLASTRI	Was runner up with a pretty solid effort on debut at Catterick over 1210m. Is second up here and likely to be fitter and ready for this. Don't discount.
3	MIRROR KISSES	Was sent forward on debut and gave a sight but faded to finish eighth at Sandown Park. Further improved and gets some weight relief this time. Can measure up this time.
7	VIRGINIA PLANE	Yet to place in two career starts and well beaten latest when a 7.5 lengths eighth over 1200m at Leicester. Can be further improved and could get into the finish at odds.
2	CHICA BONITA	Lope De Vega filly from the mare Hundi who is making debut. Profiles nicely and worth keeping very safe.
6	TWILIGHT LUCY	Yet to place in two career starts and well beaten latest when a 8.75 lengths sixth over 1210m at Catterick. Can be further improved and looks a minor threat.

R14 - PONTEFRACT | 19:55 | GBP £6,400 | BRITISH STALLION STUDS EBF PONTEFRACT MAIDEN STAKES

4	FOOTSTEPSTOTHEHART	Shows ability finishing in the money at both runs, the latest when third over 1200m at York. Rates highly is among the leading hopes.
9	HUMID	Open to much improvement after a fair debut when fourth over 1210m at Catterick. Shows ability and rates among the leading hopes.
11	PERFECT SUNRISE	Maiden galloper yet to find the frame in two runs, the latest when tenth over 1000m at Sandown Park. Looks well placed here and is worth giving another try.
8	HEAT AND DUST	Open to much improvement after a fair debut when fourth over 1200m at Chepstow. Solid debut and has upside.
6	SHEM	Two-year-old colt facing the starter for the first time. By leading Kodiak out of Group 1 winning dam Noahs Ark. Has the pedigree so watch for leads from market fluctuations.

R15 - PONTEFRACT | 20:25 | GBP £5,400 | FLY HIGH FAYE NICKELS HANDICAP

7	SWIFT APPROVAL	Seasoned galloper overdue a win but hasn't broken through for more than a year. Wasn't far away last time when second at Newmarket (July). Not far off a win and rates among the winning hopes.
9	WAR WHISPER	Finished midfield but beaten only 2.5 lengths when fourth over 1000m at this track. Has the ability and rates among the leading hopes.
15	GRACE AND VIRTUE	Went down by 0.75 lengths to finish second at Ayr over 1200m in latest outing. Main contender.
5	KINDLY	Returned to winning form last time when scoring by 1.75 lengths over 1200m at Hamilton Park. Going well and could follow up.
13	IVA REFLECTION	Needs to bounce back after an underwhelming performance last start, if he can replicate the form of a second place run at Ripon two back then he can stack up today. Well held latest and prefer the place.

R16 - PONTEFRACT | 20:55 | GBP £5,400 | SOLUTIONS 4 CLEANING HANDICAP

1	FRANKELIO	Course and distance winner on his penultimate start who suffered an interrupted trip when fourth at Ripon last time. Leading player again.
10	JAZZ HANDS	Faded on fresh run when seventh at Leicester. Strong claims now.
4	BACK FROM DUBAI	Three start maiden who is coming back in journey here after finishing fourth over 2000m at Windsor. Can do better here and is worth including in the multiples.
5	STRIDING EDGE	Drops in distance since last start at Hamilton Park when fifth, finishing 4.5 lengths off the winner. Is worth some thought.
8	LITTLE TED	Had a winning run broken last time out when third at Haydock Park. Rates well at peak fitness. Has each way claims.

R17 - PONTEFRACT | 21:25 | GBP £7,250 | JAYNE - ON COURSE LADY BOOKMAKER HANDICAP

2	HIGHWAYGREY	Four-year-old gelding who won last time at this distance, winning by 5 lengths at this track. Rates highly and on top record at this trip should prove hard to beat.
5	MICHELE STROGOFF	Course and distance winner who is overdue for a win, the latest when fourth but beaten only 5.5 lengths over 2000m at this track. Thereabouts lately and gets chance to break through.
1	SUDONA	Missed the placings last time over a longer journey when fourth over 2400m at Ripon. Rates fairly and definitely worth including.
3	BARYSHNIKOV	Is a six-time placegetter in twelve career starts, but still a maiden. Place looks best hope again here.
4	EL PICADOR	Fitter for two runs from a spell and wasn't far away when third over 2010m at Beverley. Not far away latest and is worth including.

R18 - PONTEFRACT | 21:55 | GBP £5,400 | RIU HOTELS AND RESORTS MAIDEN HANDICAP

4	SINGLE	Jumps out to 3430m for the first time today after a sixth place finish last time out at Beverley when well supported. Well held latest but rates highly here.
6	BLUE BEIRUT	Has been close up in recent runs including a last start third over 2600m at Bath when only 1.75 lengths from the winner. Rates highly in this and expected to be in the finish.
2	FRANKENSTELLA	Raced handy on debut. Went a little better at Wolverhampton and then placed last start at Beverley. Has upside.
8	MAISON D'OR	Resumed over 3190m and missed the placings when a 4.25 lengths fourth at Catterick. Should strip much fitter and expected to do better this time.
5	LANZEALOT	Could manage only midfield last time when seventh at Bath over 2800. Well placed here with the lighter weight and longer trip. Rates well and is worth including among the chances.

R19 - PONTEFRACT | 22:25 | GBP £10,400 | BET WITH JAYNE - YOUR LOCAL BOOKMAKER HANDICAP

2	GROVEMAN	Disappointed last time when well beaten to finish seventh beaten by 8.25 lengths over 2400m at Ripon. Can forget latest and have a better run.
4	SQUELCH	Lightly raced filly progressing well. Last start posted a 1.5 lengths win over 2400m at Doncaster. Has the ability and looks one of the major players.
5	DREAM WITH ME	Close up third at Leicester two runs back then handy again at Great Yarmouth last start. Rises in distance for this and must come into consideration.
3	WHERE'S JEFF	Not the finest form this campaign, including a very underwhelming last start at York finding eighth beaten 19 lengths. Has the ability and looks one of the chances.
1	ELECTOR	Resumed from a spell with a fourth before a disappointing seventh at York last start. Will need to show more than what he produced in latest.
