## 2nd Pick: JK FORMIDABLE (2)


Returns to the races after a freshen up. Has the pace to be hard on the speed and is capable of giving a sight fresh. Major player.

# 2nd Pick: HOTSHOTS SLAM (8)


Has the light weight and can follow Makkem Lad across. Will run a race with fitness edge/ weight difference.
