Ran through beaten horses last time out in a much stronger race and this should prove a little bit easier a task on his 5th career start. Each way chance.

Has good course and distance form to his name and ran a huge race in defeat last time out when dead-heating with Mr Hooper for 2nd. The leading jockey is booked and he should go close under ideal conditions.

3rd Pick: PAX ANIMI (13)


Needs to get a run and if doing so, is a decent chance. Has only had limited runs here so far and has looked very good, he is considered a Derby prospect and stepping up in distance now is perfect for him. If a run comes his way, he is a live chance.

4th Pick: FEDERATION (2)

Progressive type who gets on well with John Powell. A good run off this mark last time out would put him spot on for this test and the step up in trip is interesting. One for the multiples.
