

FAQ about Composite Win

Q: What is Composite Win?

A: Composite Win is an alternative way to pick the winning horse within the Win pool. Instead of choosing a winner from the usual full field of runners, all runners in a race are grouped into three or four composites (or groups) by Hong Kong Jockey Club (HKJC). The customer buys the Composite Win bet by selecting the group in which his/her desired horse is grouped in.

Q: When will Hong Kong Jockey Club (HKJC) introduce Composite Win?

A: HKJC will introduce Composite Win in Hong Kong on 25th October 2015.

Q: Will Singapore Pools be offering Composite Win?

A: No. Singapore Pools will not be offering Composite Win.

Q: Why is Singapore Pools not offering Composite Win?

A: Currently, Composite Win is not available to HKJC's commingling partners. However, Singapore Pools and HKJC will explore the feasibility of introducing Composite Win in the future.

Q: Will HKJC's introduction of Composite Win affect the current commingling arrangement with HKJC?

A: No. The introduction of Composite Win will not affect the current commingling arrangement with HKJC.

Q: How does Composite Win affect me?

A: The Composite Win betting pool will be merged with the Win betting pool to become a combined pool. With a bigger betting pool, customers can enjoy greater dividend stability.
