

RACE 1: YORKSHIRE JUMPS RACING IS BACK SELLING STAKES

Embolden Straight Ash Manzo Duro

EMBOLDEN has the highest rating in this field with a mark of 75 and could go prove too strong for the opposition under Silvestre De Sousa. The three-year-old returned to a bit of form when second at Leicester eight days ago, and it is a further positive that he has tasted success at this venue in the past. Straight Ash found just one too good here recently and may appreciate this drop in distance. Manzo Duro also makes some appeal on stable debut for Robert Eddery.

RACE 2: EVERYPOPPYCOUNTS HANDICAP (DIV 1)

Jewel Maker Convertible Highlight Reel

Convertible remains open to improvement after just two starts and, on pedigree, won't mind this step up in distance. Highlight Reel (first) was ahead of Real Smooth (fourth) here last week and is fancied to confirm that form, but the vote goes the way of JEWEL MAKER. Tim Easterby's five-year-old finished his race off well when fourth in a competitive Ayr contest and the assessor has dropped him 1lb.

Ideal Candy Roong Roong Josiebond

IDEAL CANDY hasn't been at her best the last twice, but she was third at Beverley off 63 and 66 during the summer so has to be viewed as well handicapped off 60. At her best when allowed to dictate, there isn't much pace in this contest and things could fall into the five-year-old's favour. Roong Roong is likely better than she showed at Southwell most recently, while Josiebond displayed more when fourth at Wolverhampton on Saturday.

BILL PEYTO showed plenty of potential when second on debut behind a potentially smart type at Newmarket and can go one better. His dam is closely related to a Melbourne Cup winner and although he should do better over further as he develops, this is a nice enough opening. Le Cheval Rapide has put in two encouraging performances so far, including when a neck second over C&D. Wizard D'amour makes most appeal of the newcomers.
