RACE 1: STAR SPORTS FESTIVAL OF RACING NURSERY

Let's Celebrate Made Of Lir Sherman Klumpf

LET'S CELEBRATE has only beaten two horses home in her three starts to date, but she finished on the heels of the winner when fourth of four at Bath last time and could fare better now switched to nurseries, especially in this field. Made Of Lir was sent off favourite at Ffos Las last time so evidently better was expected of her there and she may prefer a sounder surface, while Sherman Klumpf's best run was when third at Beverley in May but he's been given a chance by the handicapper.

- 2 SHERMAN KLUMPF Foaled 12 Feb. Yet to place in five starts. Finished 3 1/2l behind Kodi Dancer when fifth of 7 at 20-1 on his latest outing at Southwell over 5f last month.
- 3 POPPY FIELD Foaled 22 Jan. Yet to place in four starts. Finished 8l behind Royal Mariner when fourth of 5 at 25-1 on her latest outing at Lingfield over 6f last month.
- 4 LET'S CELEBRATE Foaled 29 Mar. Yet to place in three starts. Finished 1 1/4l behind Crikey Juicy when last of 4 at 16-1 on her latest outing at Bath over 5f (firm) last month.

Inspirited Cite D'Or Artistic Girl

INSPIRITED made a favourable impression on his debut at Yarmouth, taking third despite being slowly away, showing signs of greenness and meeting trouble in running. Cite D'Or cost just 10,000 euros as a yearling but was snapped up for 43,000 euros as a two-year-old, suggesting she was showing something at least, while Charlie and Mark Johnston's Artistic Girl has yet to beat a horse home in two starts to date but could still make an impact.

- 1 INSPIRITED Foaled 15 Jan. Half-brother to Cubswin, won seven times over hurdles between 1m 7f and 2m 2f and twice on the flat at 1m 4f. Third of 9 behind Liberation Bay beaten 3l at 6-1 on his racecourse debut at Yarmouth over 6f (good to firm) in June.
- 2 ARTISTIC GIRL Foaled 25 Mar. Half-sister to The Stalking Moon, won five times between 6f and 1m. Unplaced in both starts. Beaten 10l behind Wan'em at 20-1 when last of 7 on her latest outing at Catterick over 7f (good to firm) last month.

- 3 CITE D'OR Foaled 28 Mar. Dam a lightly raced maiden.
- 4 PRIMROSE WAY Foaled 24 Mar. Full sister to Bluebell Way, won at 6f. Well beaten at 28-1 behind Signcastle City when last of 6 on her racecourse debut at Salisbury over 6f (firm) last month.
- 5 WHAT AN ICON Foaled 25 Feb. Full sister to Fannie By Gaslight, won three times at 1m 2f and 1m 4f. Unplaced in both starts. Finished 6l behind Bonnsie when sixth of 8 at 33-1 on her latest outing at Lingfield over 7f last month.

RACE 3: DAVID BENNETT HANDICAP

Wisper Arclight Gangway

WISPER positively bolted up in a handicap over this C&D two starts ago and continued in good form when second at Epsom last time. Marcus Tregoning's charge evidently enjoys undulating tracks and can strike at the expense of Arclight, who ran a respectable race when third on her reappearance at Sandown. Gangway was behind the selection at Epsom but put in a better display when third at Redcar last time.

- 2 WISPER She has won three times at 1m 2f on good to firm and soft ground. Beaten 1 3/4l by Night Of Luxury when second of 4 at 9-4 on her latest outing at Epsom over 1m 2f (good to firm) last month. Has won twice at Brighton this season.
- 3 HEADSHOT Successful at 1m and 1m 1f on good to firm ground and on the all-weather. Finished 6l behind Magical Mile when sixth of 13 at 16-1 on his latest outing at Windsor over 1m 2f (good to firm) in June.
- 4 ARCLIGHT A winner at 1m on the all-weather. Third of 8 behind New Heights beaten 3l at 13-2 on her latest outing at Sandown over 1m 1f (good to firm) last month.
- 5 HE'S OUR STAR He has won four times from 7f to 1m on good to firm and good ground. Well beaten at 14-1 behind Zulu Tracker when fourth of 5 on his latest outing at Newbury over 7f (good to firm) last month.
- 6 JUNOESQUE Has won 12 races from 1m to 1m 4f on ground varying from good to firm to soft and on the all-weather. Third of 4 behind Heat And Dust beaten 7l at 10-3 on her latest outing here over 1m 4f (good to firm) last month. Has won twice at Brighton this season.

Night Eagle Bug Boy Percy Jones

NIGHT EAGLE's winning run came to an end last time but he was very unlucky to bump into an extremely well-handicapped rival on that occasion. Off a 1lb lower mark today, Gary Moore's gelding could return to winning ways. The hat-trick seeking Bug Boy is an obvious threat to the selection, while Percy Jones and Caramelised also merit places on the shortlist.

- 1 FAIRMAC He has won three times from 7f to 1m 2f on good to firm and good to soft ground. Finished 3 1/2l behind Awesome Dancer when fourth of 11 at 12-1 on his latest outing at Ascot over 1m 4f (good to firm) last month.
- 2 SPRING GLOW She has won three times from 1m 3f to 1m 4f on the all-weather. Finished 6l behind Perfect Alibi when fourth of 6 at 8-1 on her latest outing at Newbury over 1m 5f (good to firm) last month.
- 3 CAMELISED A winner at 4-1 at Bath over 1m 5f (firm) on his latest flat outing in June, beating Choirmaster by 2l.
- 4 DUNDORY He has won three times from 1m to 1m 2f on ground varying from good to firm to heavy. Finished 6l behind Bug Boy when fourth of 8 at 5-2fav on his latest outing at Chepstow over 1m 4f (good) last month. Has won twice at Chepstow this season.
- 5 BAKERSBOY A winner at 1m 2f on the all-weather. Finished 9l behind Party Island when fourth of 10 at 14-1 on his latest outing at Lingfield over 1m 4f last month.
- 6 POSTWICK Placed once in four starts. Beaten 9l by Honiton when second of 11 at 8-1 on his latest outing at Sandown over 1m 2f (good to firm) in June.
- 7 PERCY JONES Placed twice in six starts. Finished 6l behind Nathanael Greene when fifth of 14 at 18-1 on his latest outing at Haydock over 1m 6f (soft) last month.
- 8 NIGHT EAGLE Winner of five races from 1m 2f to 1m 4f on good ground and on the all-weather. Beaten 12l by Caius Chorister when second of 3 at 5-2 on his latest outing at Epsom over 1m 4f (good to firm) last month. Has won at Epsom and Lingfield this season.
- 9 BUG BOY Winner of five races from 1m 2f to 1m 4f on good to firm and good ground and on the all-weather. A winner at 9-2 at Chepstow over 1m 4f (good) on his latest outing last month, beating Baez by a neck. Has also won at Kempton this season.
- 10 CHERRY COLA She has won four times from 1m 3f to 1m 6f on good to firm and soft ground. Third of 5 behind Sovereign Duke beaten 2l at 10-3 on her latest outing at Sandown over 1m 6f (good to firm) last month.
