### RACE 4: RACINGTV.COM PRESTONPANS HANDICAP

**Lord Riddiford      Jabbarockie      Ornate**

In this competitive contest it may pay dividends to side with LORD RIDDIFORD, who comfortably dismissed a strong field of 12 at Goodwood last time out. Although he may want as much moisture in the ground as possible, he is 2lb well-in and could take all the beating. Jabbarockie failed to fire in Listed company on his latest outing and the return to a sounder surface should benefit. The eight-year-old must be taken seriously off top-weight, while Ornate is another to consider.

- 1      JABBAROCKIE      Has won nine races at 5f on ground varying from good to firm to soft and on the all-weather. Finished 10l behind Liberty Beach when last of 6 at 9-1 on his latest outing in the Group 2 Temple Stakes at Haydock over 5f (heavy) in May. Has won at Chester and Musselburgh this season.
- 2      MAKANAH      Winner of six races from 5f to 6f on ground varying from good to firm to soft. Beaten 11l behind Significantly at 20-1 when last of 18 on his latest outing at Ascot over 5f (good) last month.
- 3      SUNDAY SOVEREIGN      Successful at 5f and 6f on soft and yielding ground, but last win was over two years ago. Finished 3 1/2l behind Lord Riddiford when fourth of 12 at 8-1 on his latest outing at Goodwood over 5f (soft) last month.
- 4      ORNATE      Has won ten races at 5f on good to firm and good ground and on the all-weather. Beaten 12l behind Suesa at 200-1 when 12th of 13 on his latest outing in the Group 2 King George Qatar Stakes at Goodwood over 5f (good to soft) last month.
- 5      LORD RIDDIFORD      Has won ten races at 5f on ground varying from good to firm to soft and on the all-weather. A winner at 13-2 at Goodwood over 5f (soft) on his latest outing last month, beating El Astronaute by 2 1/2l. Carries a 5lb penalty today for that success. Has won 3 times this season.
- 6      EMBOUR      Winner of seven races from 5f to 6f on ground varying from good to firm to good to soft and on the all-weather. Beaten 12l behind Mr Wagyu at 66-1 when 17th of 25 on his latest outing at Goodwood over 6f (soft) last month.
- 7      WRENTHORPE      Winner of five races at 5f on ground varying from good to firm to heavy. Finished 7l behind Dave Dexter when sixth of 7 at 9-1 on his latest outing at Catterick over 5f (good to soft) in May.
- 8      MOKAATIL      Winner of six races from 5f to 6f on ground varying from good to firm to good to soft and on the all-weather. Beaten 6l behind Mr Wagyu at 66-1 when 9th of 25 on his latest outing at Goodwood over 6f (soft) last month. Has won at Epsom and Chelmsford City this season.
