### RACE 1: BRITISH STALLION STUDS EBF NOVICE STAKES (GBB RACE)

Muskateer One was hampered at the start when finishing sixth on her debut at Kempton recently and she should put in a better performance with that experience now under her belt. That said, preference is for ANGEL BLEU, who cost 100,000 euro as a yearling and he is from the family of Highland Reel and Idaho. The trip would have to be a slight concern for the son of Dark Angel but the fact that he is making his debut so early in the year suggests that he is showing plenty at home. Others to consider are Crypto Quest and Gubbass.

Jewel In My Crown is another who could go well.

DIRTY RASCAL looked to win with plenty in hand over 6f at Wolverhampton on Monday and a 5lb penalty might not be enough to anchor him if arriving in the same mood. Soaring Star has undergone wind surgery since his second at Doncaster in October and warrants respect on his return to action, while Harbour Vision and Trinity Lake are other names to note.
