RACE 1: IRISH STALLION FARMS EBF FILLIES MAIDEN

Impeachd Alexander Arewecrystalclear Ladies Church

IMPEACHD ALEXANDER finished a length and a half behind Arewecrystalclear over course and distance last month but is fancied to turn the tables. The Jessica Harrington-trained filly didn't have the best of starts when making her debut on that occasion but kept on nicely without being given a hard time. With the benefit of that experience, and on 2lb better terms, she can reverse placings with Arewecrystalclear, who also showed promise on her previous start at Naas. Ladies Church is an interesting newcomer having cost 160,000 at the Goffs Orby Sale. She's out of a Listed juvenile winner in France and from the family of Oh So Sharp. Timiyra, a half-sister to Tirmizi who won as a two-year-old for Dermot Weld, is another newcomer to keep a close eye on in the market.

RACE 2: MALLOW MAIDEN

Stalingrad No Browsin Simba Power

STALINGRAD is very exposed but a generally consistent sort and may finally open his account here. The Fozzy Stack-trained son of War Front is a free-running type and made a bold bid from the front when pegged back inside the final furlong at Listowel last Saturday. This sounder surface should suit. No Browsin ran a cracker when beaten less than a length on debut at Dundalk just before Christmas and was perhaps unsuited by soft ground when reappearing here last month. Simba Power has indicated ability on both outings, while Cooper's Hawk showed promise as a juvenile for Jessica Harrington and now makes a belated reappearance in the care of Paddy Hayes.

- 9 CURRAHEEN PRINCESS Dam a lightly raced maiden.
- 10 NO BROWSIN Placed once in two starts. Beaten 19l behind Can'thelpfallin at 20-1 when 14th of 17 on her latest outing here over 7f (yielding - soft) last month.
- 11 SIMBA POWER Unplaced in both starts. Beaten 6l behind White Lavender at 11-1 when 9th of 21 on her latest outing at Navan over 6f (good) last month.
- 12 SPANISH CLASS Unplaced in both starts. Beaten 13l behind Ramon Di Loria at 5-1 when seventh of 13 on her latest outing at Sligo over 6f (good - yielding) last month.

RACE 3: MIDSUMMER SPRINT STAKES (LISTED)**Logo Hunter****Russian River****Frenetic**

LOGO HUNTER has been a revelation this season, belying his 5000 guineas purchase price with a succession of excellent efforts, including when bolting up in a Listed contest at Naas last time. Though penalised for that run here, he could still prove too strong for his rivals while evidently on good terms with himself. Queens Carriage picked up where she left off last term when completing a hat-trick in a small-field affair at Fairyhouse last month, while Russian River went close in a Listed contest over this track and trip most recently and cannot be overlooked. Frenetic was a classy sort last term and is a danger to all if returning in top form.

3 A STEP TOO FAR Winner of six races from 5f to 6f on ground varying from good to heavy. Beaten 4l behind Master Matt at 12-1 when 9th of 14 on her latest outing at Tipperary over 5f (yielding) earlier this month. She is wearing blinkers for the first time.

4 BACK TO BRUSSELS Successful at 5f and 6f on yielding and heavy ground. Beaten 6l behind Sonaiyla at 15-2 when 9th of 13 on her latest outing in the Group 3 Ballyogan Stakes at Curragh over 6f (yielding) earlier this month.

5 MY LAUREATE Successful twice at 5f on good to firm ground and on the all-weather. Third of 14 behind Urban Beat beaten 1/2l at 6-4fav on her latest outing in the Group 3 Al Basti Equiworld, Dubai Pat Smullen Mercury Stakes at Dundalk over 5f in October last year.

6 EROSANDPSYCHE A winner at 5f on yielding ground. Beaten 12l behind Measure Of Magic at 5-1 when last of 9 on his latest outing at Navan over 6f (good) in April.

7 QUARANTINE DREAMS A winner at 12-1 over this course and distance (good to firm) on his latest outing last month, beating Jon Riggins by 2 3/4l. He is wearing a visor for the first time.

8 DICKIEDOODA Successful twice at 5f on good to firm and good ground. Finished 6l behind Measure Of Magic when sixth of 8 at 10-1 on her latest outing here over 5f (good to firm) last month. She is wearing a tongue-tie for the first time.

9 FRENETIC She has won four times from 5f to 6f on good to firm and good ground and on the all-weather. Won on her latest outing when 3-1fav at Dundalk over 5f in October last year, beating Giselles Thunder by a neck.

10 SANTOSHA Successful twice at 6f on good to firm and good ground. Beaten 7l behind A Case Of You at 20-1 when seventh of 9 on her latest outing in the Group 3 Goffs Lacken Stakes at Naas over 6f (soft) last month.

11 QUEENS CARRIAGE She has won three times from 5f to 6f on soft - heavy ground and on the all-weather. A winner at 11-10 at Fairyhouse over 6f (soft - heavy) on her latest outing last month, beating Master Matt by a short head.

12 RUSSIAN RIVER A winner at 6f on the all-weather. Beaten 3 1/2l by Measure Of Magic when second of 8 at 16-1 on her latest outing here over 5f (good to firm) last month.

A trio of last-time-out winners all have to be respected here, as White Lavender struck when getting up on the line on debut at Navan, while Mi Esperanza ended a sequence of near-misses with victory at Naas last time. Chocquinto was a narrow winner at Down Royal and completes the threesome, but it might be worth opposing them with MRS BOUQUET. Jack Davison's filly has put in a couple of

solid efforts in defeat so far this term and is 1lb lower than when fourth at Navan last time. The booking of Colin Keane catches the eye and she is well worth a chance in this.

Moll Silence Please French Fusion

Having already been acquired by American-based owners Team Valor, it wasn't a sales pitch when Paddy Twomey remarked after her Listed course and distance win in April that MOLL "has top class ability and I wasn't messing when I supplemented her for the (2020) Irish Oaks". She missed the latter engagement through injury and her trainer will be hoping that the ground here isn't too firm, but she did the job well last time when she had Haparanda and Mighty Blue in arrears. In the same

ownership, Silence Please looks a danger if leaving behind a moderate effort at York. She finished a neck ahead of the selection over 1m2f at Naas last year and chased home Melbourne Cup runner-up Tiger Moth over this trip at Leopardstown. French Fusion may improve for stepping up in trip and looks best of the three-year-olds.
