RACE 1: MANSIONBET BET 10 GET 20 EBF NOVICE STAKES (GBB RACE)

Love De Vega **Sterling Knight** **King's Guard**

LOVE DE VEGA has shaped with lots of promise in two starts over 5f and could make it third-time lucky now stepping up in distance. Sterling Knight made a pleasing debut when fourth over this trip at Newbury last month and he is likely to show up well here, while King's Guard and Canmore are both interesting newcomers representing powerful connections.

- 4 ROCCOZAAM Foaled 25 Feb. Dam won at 7f. Finished 6l behind Gypsy Lady when sixth of 13 at 10-3 on his racecourse debut at Chelmsford City over 6f earlier this month.
- 5 STERLING KNIGHT Foaled 2 Apr. Half-brother to Charmed, won at 5f. Finished 9l behind Gisburn when fourth of 13 at 25-1 on his racecourse debut at Newbury over 6f (good to soft) last month.

Satono Chevalier **Matamua** **Moonlit Cloud**

Matamua does look capable of winning a race of this nature and hopefully a first-time hood helps her, while Moonlit Cloud merits consideration following her pleasing introduction over C&D last month. However, a chance is taken on newcomer SATONO CHEVALIER, who cost 450,000 euros as a yearling and represents a top yard that have been amongst the winners of late.

RACE 3: MANSIONBET WATCH AND BET HANDICAP

Dereham Denable Paintball Wizard

DEREHAM ran out a comfortable winner over this trip at Yarmouth 22 days ago and, entitled to improve for that first start since October, he is fancied to defy a 7lb hike in the ratings. Denable was surrounded by subsequent winners when runner-up over 1m4f at Southwell last time and he warrants respect stepping up in trip off the same mark, while Paintball Wizard could also run well off his light weight.

- 3 MAJOR SNUGFIT Successful at 7f and 1m 4f on good ground. Finished 2 3/4l behind Galidermes when fifth of 12 at 16-1 on his latest outing at Thirsk over 1m 4f (good to firm) earlier this month.

- 4 DENABLE Placed once in four starts. Beaten 6l by Scudamore when second of 9 at 4-1 on his latest outing at Southwell over 1m 4f in April.

Muscika Typhoon Ten Wentworth Falls

MUSCIKA bounced right back to form when beaten a neck in a competitive Epsom contest last week and could take advantage of the same rating to land a telling blow here. Typhoon Ten was denied by a nose off this figure at Brighton recently and could prove a real danger arriving in top form. The best of Lethal Lunch's form is over 7f but he is foolish to ignore nonetheless, while Wentworth Falls is a course winner and was an encouraging second off this mark at Thirsk in April.

- 2 MUSCIKA Winner of seven races from 5f to 6f on ground varying from good to firm to soft. Beaten a neck by Ejtilaab when second of 9 at 25-1 on his latest outing at Epsom over 6f (good to soft) earlier this month.
- 3 TYPHOON TEN He has won three times from 6f to 7f on good to firm ground and on the all-weather. Beaten a nose by Mamillius when second of 7 at 9-2 on his latest outing at Brighton over 6f (good to firm) last month.
- 4 WENTWORTH FALLS Winner of six races from 5f to 6f on good to firm and good ground and on the all-weather. Beaten 2 1/4l by Manigordo when second of 11 at 14-1 on his latest outing at Thirsk over 6f (good to firm) in April.

RACE 5: MANSIONBET BET 10 GET 20 HANDICAP (DIV 1)

Refuge **Lexington Liberty** **Soyounique**

REFUGE is only 1lb higher than when both second here earlier this season and also when beaten a neck at Ripon last time. He could be the one to side with stepping up in trip here in a first-time visor. Lexington Liberty has made the podium off this rating the last twice and has to be considered, while Soyounique brings some smart form from the all-weather with him as he switches to turf.
