RACE 1: DUBAI NURSERY Tawaareq Series Of Dreams Zoffarelli

TAWAAREQ confirmed the potential that he displayed on debut by winning at Doncaster last month, and the promising son of Shamardal could prove to be underestimated by an opening mark of 84. Series Of Dreams was out of her depth in an Ayr Group 3, but she had previously been progressive and should not be underestimated in this company. Others to note are Zoffarelli, Inveigle and Fairmac.

RACE 2: GODOLPHIN FLYING START ZETLAND STAKES (GROUP 3)

Kyprios Lone Eagle Recovery Run Lone Eagle sets a respectable standard having won a nursery at Doncaster last time off a mark of 84 and he should have no problem seeing out the trip given how well he stayed on that day. However, preference is for KYPRIOS, who overcame greenness to make a winning debut at Galway a month ago. He is another who should relish this trip and Aidan O'Brien has won two of the last three renewals of this contest. The consistent Recovery Run has a similar profile to Lone Eagle, having come through the nursery ranks, and he could pick up some minor money, while Fabilis is going in the right direction.

RACE 3: EMIRATES AUTUMN STAKES (GROUP 3) Latest Generation
 Maximal Dhahabi A race that has been won by the likes of Persian King and Ghaaiyyath in recent years, and LATEST GENERATION can add his name to the roll of honour. He caught the eye when third behind One Ruler and Maximal on debut at Sandown, with those rivals having the benefit of race experience and fitness. The son of Frankel then made no mistake when getting off the mark at Doncaster, where he arguably had more in hand than the official winning distance suggested, and he should have no problem handling this stiffer test. One Ruler and Maximal are obvious threats again, especially as they remain open to further improvement themselves. Van Gogh broke through in a Curragh maiden but previously hit the crossbar in a Group 2, while Dhahabi could put in a career best now stepped up in trip.

RACE 4: DARLEY DEWHURST STAKES (GROUP 1) Chindit Thunder Moon
Alkumait This appears to be a very strong Dewhurst, with marginal preference for the unbeaten CHINDIT, who was an impressive winner of the Champagne Stakes at Doncaster. The son of Wootton Bassett may still have more improvement left to come and his form appears to be rock-solid. His biggest threat is likely to be Thunder Moon after he scored at the highest level in the National Stakes. Joseph O'Brien's colt was a decisive winner at the Curragh and is a very exciting prospect. Alkumait accounted for Fivethousandtoone in the Mill Reef and he has to be of some interest, although the step up in trip is a slight concern.

Just Fine has a similar profile to the selection and the recent Sandown winner may have more improvement left to come. The hat-trick seeking Classic Lord is a proven soft-ground performer and he has an obvious chance, while Galah completes the shortlist.

Ed Walker's charge beat the 97-rated Magical Morning on that occasion, keeping on strongly in the closing stages, and could relish this extra yardage.

Kevin Ryan is another handler with a great record in this and Ayr Silver Cup winner Magical Spirit could be the pick of his trio. However, it might be the Ayr Gold Cup form which proves key and the third, MR LUPTON, a winner at the Curragh on his penultimate start, can continue his fine form this campaign. Soldier's Minute, fourth on that occasion, has a fine record here and is respected, while Kynren caught the eye in fifth when dropping back in trip. Roulston Scar and Came From The Dark both arrive on the back of victory and are others to note.
