COMMENT AND SELECTIONS - ROSCOMMON

RACE 1: IRISH EBF MEDIAN SIRES SERIES MAIDEN

Cool And Clever Pilbara Gold Tumultuous

This ground is likely to be very testing come race time which shouldn't bother Vocalised colt COOL AND CLEVER. Jim Bolger's charge kept on for fourth on his debut on rain-softened ground at Cork last month, and the runner-up has since obliged in Listed company at the Curragh to give the form a big boost. Tumultuous can build upon a debut sixth in the Curragh particularly with the same runnerup endorsing the form. Pilbara Gold was nicely backed before her debut fifth in the Curragh last week. She can finisher closer this time. Sunset Shiraz is from a yard that wouldn't typically be associated with juvenile winners, but she is a half-sister to a horse that won at Listed level and as a two-year-old in Britain. Similar comments apply to Molly's Gamble who is related to a couple of multiple winners.

Lust For Life Designer Cailin Sincerest

LUST FOR LIFE has each-way claims off top-weight. it is probably best to put a line through her last effort in Dundalk when out the back as, afterwards, her jockey reported that she didn't handle the track. She is interesting based on her penultimate run when victorious on soft ground over seven furlongs in Gowran Park. She stayed on from a fair bit back in her first handicap and could repeat the feat here. Designer Cailin was fourth behind Lust For Life in that aforementioned race, beaten over three lengths, and certainly has prospects with a swing in the weights. Sincerest kept on well for fourth in Cork but that was on fast ground, and she still has to show a fondness for deep ground. Lord Dudley tries a new trip after running on for third over five furlongs in Naas.

STAR OF CASHEL won three in a row last summer, including over course and distance on heavy ground, and has returned in good shape this term. Fourth in the Irish Lincoln, he followed that with a good third at Naas and the two horses immediately behind him that day have won since. Comfort Line (now 3lbs worse off) was half a length in front of the selection at the Curragh and this is more like his level than the Group Three he contested last time. Maud Gonne Spirit may be a lot sharper for her comeback run last week and was twice a winner over this trip on testing ground last year, while conditions will also suit Galtee Mist who's had a recent run and represents an in-form yard.

Zero Turn didn't progress from a promising debut third on soft ground at Killarney last year in two subsequent starts but still looks next best. Florence Camille was beaten less than a length by the now 101-rated Yaxeni on her debut in 2019 but made no impact in her only run last year and was beaten a long way on her third career start at Gowran a week ago.
