RACE 8: VEOLIA NURSERY (DIV 1) (CLASS 6) (2YO ONLY) (FROM LEICESTER RACE 1)MihrabGypsy BoyDevil's CubMIHRAB has been thrown in at the deep end inthree career starts so far, but his run at Yarmouth in August caught the eye when only beaten just oversix lengths despite finishing last, and an opening nursery mark of 62 might prove lenient. The booking oftitle-chasing rider William Buick catches the eye, and the pair could account for Gypsy Boy, who hasshaped well on Tapeta the last twice. Devil's Cub won at Bath earlier in the season and is also noted.

Eve Johnson Houghton's colt shaped much better recently on his first start since a wind operation, and this isn't a particularly strong race on paper for the time of year. Top Of The Pops cost 60,000gns at the Breeze-Up sales earlier in the year, while Wallem's dam won over this trip in her native France.

Second behind Cornwallis winner Winter Power before finishing a respectable third at Musselburgh, this softer ground is fancied to suit the two-year-old and she could take some stopping.
