RACE 1: PLAY 4 TO SCORE AT BETWAY APPRENTICE HANDICAP

Big Time Maybe

Coolagh Magic

Bungledupinblue

In an open race the marginal preference is for BIG TIME MAYBE, who was not beaten far over 5f here 10 days ago and he should have no problem handling the step up in trip. Coolagh Magic scored over 7f here in September and he should not be discounted, while Bungledupinblue and Vincenzo Coccotti are the pick of the remainder.

NO. HORSE NAME

- 1 COOLAGH MAGIC He has won three times from 5f to 7f on the all-weather (1 FB, 1 PO). Third of 12 behind Starter For Ten beaten 1 3/4l at 3-1 on his latest outing at Kempton over 6f in December last year.
- 2 SHANGHAI ROCK Successful at 5f and 6f including a win on polytrack. Beaten 9l behind Strong Power at 28-1 when seventh of 9 on his latest outing here over 5f earlier this month.
- 3 WON LOVE Yet to place in seven starts. Beaten 12l behind Kodi Gold at 6-1 when eighth of 10 on his latest outing at Kempton over 6f in November last year.
- 4 BIG TIME MAYBE Has won eight races at 5f including 5 wins on the all-weather (1 FB, 3 PO). Third of 9 behind Porfin beaten 1 3/4l at 11-2 on his latest outing here over 5f earlier this month.
- 5 JULIE JOHNSTON Successful twice at 6f including a win on polytrack. Beaten 6l behind Nubough at 50-1 when seventh of 9 on her latest outing over this course and distance in December last year.
- 6 SEPRANI She has won three times at 6f including 2 wins on polytrack, but last win was over three years ago. Beaten 17l behind Covert Mission at 80-1 when last of 14 on her latest outing at Kempton over 7f earlier this month.
- 7 IMPRESSIONS DREAM Placed once in seven starts. Beaten 11l behind Intervention at 100-1 when 10th of 11 on her latest outing at Wolverhampton over 7f earlier this month.
- 8 BUNGLEDUPINBLUE A winner at 6f on polytrack. Finished 4l behind Patontheback when fourth of 12 at 14-1 on her latest outing at Southwell over 6f in December last year.
- 9 ONE DAY A winner at 5f. Beaten 4 1/2l behind Porfin at 125-1 when eighth of 9 on her latest outing here over 5f earlier this month.
- 10 VINCENZO COCCOTTI Has won nine races from 6f to 7f including 7 wins on the all-weather (5 PO). Beaten 15l behind Monsieur Fantaisie at 14-1 when last of 10 on his latest outing at Chelmsford City over 6f earlier this month.

RACE 2: READ KATIE WALSH ON BETWAY INSIDER HANDICAP

Race Card **Lady Pendragon** **Cafe Sydney**

A case can be made for all of these but the vote goes to RACE CARD, who got off the mark over 1m4f at Wolverhampton last week and a 5lb penalty (essentially 4lb as he was 1lb wrong that day) may not be enough to stop him this afternoon. Lady Pendragon was only beaten a neck over C&D last month and she has to be on the shortlist, while Cafe Sydney is another to consider.

- 1 LADY PENDRAGON Successful twice at 1m 2f on polytrack. Beaten a neck by Semser when second of 5 at 2-1 on her latest outing over this course and distance in December last year.
- 2 RACE CARD A winner at 4-1 at Wolverhampton over 1m 4f on his latest outing earlier this month, beating Eagle One by 2 1/4l. Carries a 5lb penalty today for that success.
- 3 SOURIRE SECRET A winner at 1m. Well beaten at 6-1 behind Sophosc when eighth of 9 on his latest outing at Wolverhampton over 1m 4f in December last year.
- 4 REECEL TIC A winner at 1m 4f on polytrack. Well beaten at 14-1 behind Ascot Day when 10th of 11 on his latest outing at Epsom over 1m 4f (good to soft) in July last year.
- 5 CAFE SYDNEY Winner of five races from 1m 2f to 1m 4f including 3 wins on polytrack. Beaten 1 1/2l by No Flies On Me when second of 13 at 9-2 on her latest outing here over 1m 2f earlier this month.

RACE 3: PLAY CORAL RACING-SUPER-SERIES FOR FREE FILLIES' HANDICAP

Classy Dame **Nuble** **Who Cares Wins**

Nuble is bound to be popular in her bid for a hat-trick but a 5lb penalty for her narrow victory over C&D last weekend has to be a concern. With that in mind, preference is for CLASSY DAME, who is a dual C&D winner and she was only beaten a short head here when last seen 11 days ago. Who Cares Wins edges out Gleneaglet and Santa Florentina to be the pick of the rest.

- 1 NUBLE Successful at 1m 1f and 1m 2f on the all-weather (1 PO). A winner at 9-2 over this course and distance on her latest outing earlier this month, beating Sea Of Charm by a neck. Carries a 5lb penalty today for that success.
- 2 GLENEAGLET Placed in three of nine starts. Well beaten at 5-1 behind Carausius when 10th of 12 on her latest outing at Southwell over 1m 4f in December last year.
- 3 CLASSY DAME She has won three times at 1m 2f including 2 wins on polytrack. Beaten a short head by Melakaz when second of 10 at 4-1 on her latest outing over this course and distance earlier this month.
- 4 WHO CARES WINS Placed twice in nine starts. Finished 3 1/2l behind Billy Roberts when sixth of 9 at 85-40fav on her latest outing at Wolverhampton over 1m 1f in December last year.

5 SANTA FLORENTINA Placed once in seven starts. Finished 11l behind Pretty Sweet when fourth of 7 at 10-1 on her latest outing at Kempton over 1m 3f in December last year.

RACE 4: WATCH RACING FREE ONLINE AT CORAL HANDICAP

Already Gone Achnamara Mashkuur

ALREADY GONE took a big step forward when stepped up to this trip last time and a repeat of that success could be on the cards off just 2lb higher. Mashkuur was a length behind the selection in that contest and a first-time visor might help him get even closer here, while Achnamara made a decent fist of things when second on his handicap debut over a similar trip at Wolverhampton last time. Handicap debutant Silverscape is another who cannot be ignored in a competitive affair.

- 1 SILVERSCAPE A winner at 1m on polytrack. Finished 5l behind Khathak when fifth of 11 at 8-1 on his latest outing at Kempton over 1m in December last year.
- 2 ACHNAMARA Placed in three of four starts. Beaten 3/4l by State Legend when second of 4 at 3-1 on his latest outing at Wolverhampton over 1m 1f earlier this month.
- 3 MASHKUUR Placed twice in four starts. Beaten 1l by Already Gone when second of 5 at 9-4 on his latest outing over this course and distance in December last year.
- 4 ALREADY GONE Successful at 7f and 1m 2f including a win on polytrack. A winner at 9-2 over this course and distance on his latest outing in December last year, beating Mashkuur by 1l.
- 5 U A E FIFTY Unplaced in all six starts. Finished 1l behind Mcqueen when fourth of 7 at 12-1 on his latest outing at Kempton over 1m earlier this month.

RACE 5: MANSIONBET PROUD PARTNERS OF THE AWC HANDICAP

Capla Spirit Keep Right On Blue Flame

Blue Flame won narrowly over this trip at Newcastle late last month and is only 2lb higher here, while Keep Right On gained a deserved success over this course and distance last time and has been given the same rise in the handicap. Always Dreaming cannot be ignored after going close at Wolverhampton latest, but preference is for CAPLA SPIRIT. Gay Kelleway's gelding got within half a length of success over this C&D earlier this month and gets another chance off the same mark.

- 1 RUN FORREST RUN He has won three times from 6f to 7f. Beaten 5l behind Hover at 40-1 when seventh of 14 on his latest outing at Kempton over 1m in November last year.
- 2 NEFARIOUS Successful at 6f and 7f including a win on the all-weather. Finished 1 3/4l behind Equitation when fourth of 10 at 22-1 on his latest outing at Kempton over 6f in December last year.
- 3 BLUE FLAME A winner at 3-1 at Newcastle over 7f on his latest outing in December last year, beating Shalaa Asker by a neck.

- 4 GARTH ROCKETT Has won ten races from 6f to 7f including 9 wins on polytrack. Well beaten at 66-1 behind Chookie Dunedin when last of 14 on his latest outing at Southwell over 7f in December last year.
- 5 CAPLA SPIRIT He has won three times at 5f on the all-weather (1 FB, 1 PO). Beaten 1/2l by Impeach when second of 10 at 7-1 on his latest outing here over 6f earlier this month.
- 6 ALWAYS DREAMING Placed in four of 15 starts. Beaten 1/2l by Madrinho when second of 10 at 6-1 on her latest outing at Wolverhampton over 7f in December last year.
- 7 KEEP RIGHT ON A winner at 7-1 over this course and distance on his latest outing in December last year, beating Rainbow Mirage by a head.
- 8 CAPE GRECO He has won four times from 7f to 1m 1f on the all-weather (1 FB, 2 PO). Beaten 5l behind Capla Crusader at 17-2 when seventh of 12 on his latest outing here over 1m in March last year.

RACE 6: CORAL PROUD TO SUPPORT BRITISH RACING HANDICAP

Jastar Buraback Homemade Andrea

JASTAR ran a blinder on his first start for George Boughey over 6f here 11 days ago, finishing three-parts of a length behind a 78-rated opponent when giving her 5lb, and a repeat performance would make him tough to beat in this contest. He may also improve for stretching out in distance. Course-and-distance scorer Buraback looks to be on the improve and he warrants respect equipped with a first-time hood, while Homemade Andrea and Irish Millions also hold claims.

- 3 MORE DIAMONDS Placed once in three starts. Finished 6l behind Midheaven when fifth of 10 at 5-1 on her latest outing over this course and distance in December last year.
- 4 PROVINCE Placed once in three starts. Beaten 9l behind Wee Loch Lass at 11-2 when eighth of 10 on her latest outing at Carlisle over 5f (good to soft) in May last year.
- 5 ESSENCIAL Unplaced in all three starts. Finished 7l behind Al Qareem when fifth of 10 at 8-1 on his latest outing at Newcastle over 7f in December last year.
- 6 BURABACK A winner at 7f on polytrack. Third of 12 behind New Shepard beaten 3 1/2l at 15-8fav on his latest outing at Kempton over 1m in December last year.
- 7 HOMEMADE ANDREA A winner at 7f on the all-weather. Beaten 1l by Twistaline when second of 10 at 14-1 on her latest outing here over 1m earlier this month.

RACE 7: BETWAY NOVICE STAKES

Acrion Perfect Focus Canzone

ACRION made a pleasing enough start to his racing career when fifth over 7f at Southwell last month and it's worth noting that the third from that race has won since. Dropping in trip is unlikely to bother him and a tongue-tie is now fitted, so he gets the nod in a tricky event. Perfect Focus should go close if running to his mark of 73 but that is far from certain, while Canzone and Mahale also have bits and pieces of form which give them a chance.
