

RACE 2: EBF MAIDEN FILLIES' STAKES (PLUS 10/GBB RACE) Noon Star Wootton Creek Missile

NOON STAR caught the eye when overcoming greenness on her debut to finish third at Salisbury and that form has been boosted with the winner scoring again since, while the second was narrowly beaten in a Listed race recently. The daughter of Galileo should only improve for that experience and she merits the utmost respect this afternoon. Wootton Creek only found the subsequent Oh So Sharp winner Saffron Beach too good at Newmarket last time and she is an obvious threat to the selection. Missile is arguably the most interesting newcomer having cost 725,000gns as a yearling and her dam won a Group 1 over 1m2f. Ocean Road was a 150,000gns purchase and she is closely related to Wigmore Hall.

- 1 HORSEFLY Foaled 3 Apr. Half-sister to Belle Travers, won twice at 7f and 1m 2f. Beaten 14l behind Zeyaadah at 16-1 when seventh of 10 on her racecourse debut at Beverley over 7f (good) last month.
- 2 KALMA Foaled 27 Feb. Half-sister to Madame Ellingtina, won at 7f. Unplaced in both starts. Beaten 14l behind Little Rollright at 25-1 when eighth of 9 on her latest outing at Lingfield over 1m (good) last month.
- 3 MISSILE Foaled 31 Mar. Dam won five times between 1m and 1m 2f including a Group 1 race.
- 4 MRS FITZHERBERT Foaled 18 Mar. Full sister to Moll Davis, won twice at 1m 2f and 1m 4f.
- 5 NOON STAR Foaled 7 Apr. Full sister to Midterm, won three times at 1m and 1m 2f including a Group 3 race. Third of 11 behind Lady Hayes beaten 6l at 5-2jt-fav on her racecourse debut at Salisbury over 7f (good) last month.
- 6 OCEAN ROAD Foaled 29 Apr. Half-sister to Wigmore Hall, won seven times between 1m and 1m 4f including two Group 1 races.
- 7 OUR NEW BUDDY Foaled 19 Feb. Half-sister to Twilight Payment, won seven times between 1m 4f and 2m including two Group 2 races. Finished 3 1/2l behind Ibiza Rocks when fifth of 14 at 6-1 on her racecourse debut at Newbury over 7f (good) last month.
- 8 TWILLEY Foaled 27 Feb. Dam won five times between 5f and 1m 1f. Unplaced in both starts. Beaten 11l behind Recovery Run at 100-1 when seventh of 8 on her latest outing at Sandown over 1m (good to firm) in August.
- 9 WHERE'S STEPH Foaled 17 May. Half-sister to Where's Jeff, won four times between 1m and 1m 4f. Beaten 8l behind Mashkoorah at 100-1 when 9th of 12 on her racecourse debut at Newcastle over 7f last month.
- 10 WOOTTON CREEK Foaled 3 Feb. Dam a lightly raced maiden. Placed once in two starts. Beaten 4 1/2l by Saffron Beach when second of 15 at 11-2 on her latest outing at Newmarket over 7f (good) last month.

RACE 3: WATCH AND BET AT MANSIONBET NURSERY Luxy Lou Menai Bridge Gordonstoun
LUXY LOU has improved with every start to date and the progressive filly was third to an above-average rival at Newbury last month. An opening mark of 72 appears to be fair, especially as she may have more improvement left to come. Menai Bridge and Gordonstoun are closely matched having been separated by just a short head at Kempton recently, while Coul Kat is another to note.

- 2 MARK OF RESPECT Foaled 16 Apr. A winner at 1m on good to firm ground. Finished 4 1/2l behind Impulsive One when fourth of 7 at 14-1 on his latest outing at Bath over 1m (firm) last month.
- 3 MIND THAT JET Foaled 7 Feb. Yet to place in three starts. Finished 8l behind Oo De Lally when sixth of 13 at 66-1 on his latest outing at Newbury over 7f (good) last month.
- 4 PARISH ACADEMY Foaled 23 Apr. Placed once in four starts. Third of 4 behind Act Of Wisdom beaten 4l at 15-2 on his latest outing here over 1m 2f (soft) earlier this month.
- 5 MENAI BRIDGE Foaled 5 Apr. A winner at 16-1 at Kempton over 1m on his latest outing last month, beating Gordonstoun by a short head.
- 6 SCOTS GOLD Foaled 5 Apr. Unplaced in all three starts. Finished 7l behind Calcutta Cup when fourth of 5 at 16-1 on his latest outing at Chester over 1m (good to soft) in August.
- 7 GORDONSTOUN Foaled 12 May. A winner at 7f on good to soft ground. Beaten a short head by Menai Bridge when second of 8 at 9-2 on his latest outing at Kempton over 1m last month.
- 8 TRUE COURAGE Foaled 30 Apr. Dam won twice at 1m. Unplaced in both starts. Finished 8l behind Isla Kai when fourth of 5 at 11-2 on his latest outing at Redcar over 7f (soft) last month.
- 9 DISTINCTION Foaled 3 May. Unplaced in all three starts. Third of 7 behind Mayaas beaten 5l at 100-1 on his latest outing at Musselburgh over 7f (good) last month.
- 10 COUL KAT Foaled 10 Feb. A winner at 1m on good ground. Beaten 3l by Impulsive One when second of 7 at 3-1 on his latest outing at Bath over 1m (firm) last month.
- 11 JOY CHOI Foaled 2 Feb. Unplaced in all three starts. Finished 8l behind Lovely Breeze when sixth of 14 at 22-1 on her latest outing at Kempton over 7f last month.

15 FOUR CLUBS Foaled 26 Jan. Yet to place in four starts. Beaten 16l behind Lady Danger at 33-1 when last of 14 on his latest outing at Chelmsford City over 6f earlier this month.

RACE 4: FOLLOW MANSIONBET ON TWITTER HANDICAP Balzac Vulcan Dogged BALZAC built on his sole juvenile outing when scoring at the second time of asking at Newbury in July and was sold for 30,000gns two days later at the Newmarket Horses-in-Training sale. Given time after that victory, an opening mark of 82 appears fair for what he achieved on that occasion and the son of Lope De Vega may prove to be a decent purchase for his new connections. Vulcan was an easy winner when stepped back up in trip at Haydock last month and he commands plenty of respect along with Dogged, who boasts some smart juvenile form.

1 KRYPTOS He has won three times at 1m on ground varying from good to soft, but last win was over three years ago. Beaten 14l behind Majestic Dawn at 66-1 when 15th of 27 on his latest outing at Newmarket over 1m 1f (good) last month.

2 BADENSCOTH Winner of seven races from 1m to 1m 2f on soft ground and on the all-weather. Third of 6 behind Piranesi beaten 8l at 18-1 on his latest outing at Ascot over 1m (good to soft) earlier this month.

3 VULCAN Successful at 1m and 1m 2f on good to soft and soft ground. Won on his latest outing when 2-1fav at Haydock over 1m 2f (good to soft) last month, beating Grey D'Ars by 7l. Has won twice at Haydock this season.

4 MANIGORDO A winner at 7f on good ground. Beaten 7l behind Epic Endeavour at 33-1 when 11th of 17 on his latest outing at Newbury over 7f (good) last month.

5 FURZIG Winner of five races from 7f to 1m 4f on good ground and on the all-weather. Finished 5l behind Johan when sixth of 9 at 22-1 on his latest outing at Ayr over 1m (good to soft) last month.

6 LUNAR JET He has won four times at 1m 2f on ground varying from good to firm to soft. Beaten 10l behind Eagle Court at 8-1 when seventh of 9 on his latest outing over this course and distance (soft) earlier this month.

7 MUSIC SEEKER He has won four times from 1m to 1m 2f on good to firm and soft ground. Third of 14 behind Marronnier beaten 2 1/4l at 22-1 on his latest outing at York over 1m 2f (soft) earlier this month.

8 BALZAC A winner at 4-1 at Newbury over 1m 2f (good to soft) on his latest outing in July, beating Mersin by 1l. Having his first run for a new stable today, previously with Ed Walker.

9 DOGGED A winner at 1m on good ground. Finished 4l behind Establish when fifth of 10 at 22-1 on his latest outing at Newmarket over 1m (good) in July.

RACE 5: PLAY 3-2-WIN AT MANSIONBET NURSERY Dark Illusion West Way Never Julie Johnston
DARK ILLUSION didn't get the clearest of runs when third at York last Friday and connections opt to turn out quickly before the handicapper gets a chance to reassess him. West Way Never improved from her debut when getting off the mark at Hamilton last month and she is capable of taking another step forward, while the drop to 5f is unlikely to prove an issue for Julie Johnston.

1 HOT SCOOP Foaled 9 Apr. He has won three times at 6f on ground varying from good to firm to good to soft. Beaten 16l behind Just Frank at 22-1 when 19th of 27 on his latest outing at Newmarket over 6f (soft) earlier this month. Has won 3 times this season.

2 DARK ILLUSION Foaled 10 Feb. A winner at 5f on soft ground. Third of 10 behind Imperium Blue beaten 1 1/2l at 9-2 on his latest outing at York over 5f (soft) earlier this month.

3 FANTASY MASTER Foaled 28 Apr. A winner at 80-1 over this course and distance (good) on his latest outing last month, beating Prospect by 1/2l.

4 JULIE JOHNSTON Foaled 7 Mar. Successful twice at 6f on good ground and on the all-weather. Finished 4 1/2l behind Rania when fifth of 8 at 5-1 on her latest outing at Salisbury over 6f (good) last month. Has won at York and Chelmsford City this season.

5 WEST WAY NEVER Foaled 31 Mar. Half-sister to Endeavor, won twice at 1m 2f. A winner at 5-2 at Hamilton over 5f (good) on her latest outing last month, beating Amazing Anna by 1/2l.
