RACE 1: COOLMORE STUD CALYX RACE

The Antarctic Wodao Mehmar

THE ANTARCTIC, a full brother to crack sprinter Battaash, can give the weight away. He made a winning debut on testing ground at Tipperary for which he has to carry a 3lb penalty. He beat Wodao by half a length there, after a battle inside the final furlong, and is taken to improve on this better ground. Wodao will certainly be eyeing revenge on these terms and has to rate a major threat. He holds a Listed race entry. Michael O'Callaghan takes the wraps off Mehmar and this colt is well worth checking for market strength. Little Keilee was a morning-price gamble at this track last month. She didn't run badly in fifth and champion jockey Colin Keane has now been booked.

Geocentric Logo Hunter Measure Of Magic

Logo Hunter will be sharper after an unplaced run on seasonal reappearance at Cork. he won this race by more than four lengths last year and will take plenty of beating if in the same humour. GEOCENTRIC ran creditably in second on her first start of the season in a Listed race over C&D last month. She attempted to make all but was outgunned by a former Group 1 winner at the business end. This Kodiac filly has plenty of talent. Measure Of Magic won on her second run back last season and attempts to do the same here. She finished a couple of places ahead of Logo Hunter in fifth at Cork. Brostaigh has a tough task on ratings but showed plenty of dash in fourth in Listed company in her last outing. Make A Challenge has won off a break before, but really relishes testing ground which he isn't forecast to get.

RACE 3: COOLMORE STUD IRISH EBF FILLIES SPRINT STAKES (GROUP 3)

Matilda Picotte Meditate Comhra

A cracking race. MATILDA PICOTTE was electric on debut in the Curragh as she blazed a trail and kept up the gallop to blitz her rivals. The form was boosted when the runner-up, Comhra, came out and dominated at Roscommon by six and a half lengths on Monday. Comhra reopposes again. Meditate easily got off the mark in a fillies' maiden at the Curragh last month. Aidan O'Brien commented afterwards that she could be a Royal Ascot filly so she is likely to have a big say in this Group 3. Comanche Country was only caught on the line by the favourite in a fillies' maiden at Naas which was a notable effort. La Dolce Vita was third in that race and could step forward.

5 MATILDA PICOTTE Half-sister to Haley Bop, won four times at 6f and 1m. A winner at 8-1 at Curragh over 6f (yielding) on her latest outing earlier this month, beating Comhra by 2l.

6 MEDITATE Half-sister to Mythological, won at 1m 4f. A winner at 9-4 at Curragh over 5f (yielding) on her latest outing last month, beating Drunk In Love by 3 1/2I.

7 TREASURE TROVE Dam won at 7f. Unplaced in both starts. Third of 5 behind Blackbeard beaten 2l at 17-2 on her latest outing at Curragh over 5f (yielding) earlier this month.

RACE 4: OWENSTOWN STUD STAKES (LISTED)

Diadora Bopedro Lust

DIADORA catches the eye on first start for Paddy Twomey. She had a successful career in Germany particularly when winning at Listed level and finishing third (beaten by a short head and a nose) in a Group 3 last summer. She holds an entry in a Group 2 at the Curragh later this month which would indicate she is showing up well ahead of her Irish debut. Last year's Irish Cambridgeshire winner Bopedro is more than capable of putting in a good display on his seasonal reappearance. With a mark of 107, he is entitled to plenty of respect. Lust faced a tough task at the weights against the Irish Lincoln winner in Tipperary but finished best of the rest in second and has prospects. Real Force is a solid yardstick, and a former course and distance winner.

7 PRINCESS OLLY A winner at 7f on good ground. Beaten 6l behind History at 22-1 when seventh of 11 on her latest outing in the Group 3 Cornelscourt Stakes at Leopardstown over 1m (good) earlier this month.

RACE 5: GOFFS LACKEN STAKES (GROUP 3)

New York City Straight Answer Twilight Jet

NEW YORK CITY has shown plenty of power this season with a pair of victories in Navan. His maiden success was very straightforward, but he then showed that he is a sprinter to be reckoned with when beating a deep field in the Listed Committed Stakes. After that win, connections mentioned that he could be a horse for the Commonwealth Cup at Royal Ascot. Straight Answer was a length behind New York City in that Listed race, and is rated 2lb superior to him, so is entitled to be on the premises on his second start of the campaign. Twilight Jet is on the same mark (110) as Straight Answer and won at Group 3 level last year. He has a big part to play. Straight Answer's stablemate, Beauty Inspire, is two from two and a danger to all.
