

## **RACE BY RACE PREVIEWS: KENILWORTH@2021.01.16**

### **Kenilworth, 16.01.2021, Race 1, Gallops, 1200m, Turf, R65.000, 13:50GMT+2**

**Race Summary:** Competitive opener. ADDERBURY LAKE made an eye-catching course-and-distance debut, having been all at sea in the early stages. With natural improvement should play a leading role. The same can be said of CELTIC NIGHT and ROSE PRINCESS, though, who both finished 3rd over track and trip in their respective introductions. DUCHESS OF SUSSEX disappointed over this trip 2 starts back but need only reproduce the efforts either side of that run to contest the outcome. BOLDLY GO and SNOW DRAGON are capable of making their presence felt too, while FLASHLIGHT is another who could get into the picture.

### **Kenilworth, 16.01.2021, Race 2, Gallops, 1800m, Turf, R80.000, 14:25GMT+2**

**Race Summary:** Good race. HIGH MOON wouldn't be winning out of turn after 3 consecutive 2nds, including once over this trip, and from a good draw should play a leading role. KING SALADIN bounced back to form in his first start after gelding last time and should make further progress to pose a threat. Stablemates A GOOD YEAR and VAN GOGH are both drawn wide but, with improvement likely, are capable of staking a claim. HEARTBREAK HOTEL is better than his last start suggests and on his earlier form could get into the picture. MAGNUM FIRE and BEY SUYAY have earning potential too.

### **Kenilworth, 16.01.2021, Race 3, Gallops, 1800m, Turf, R65.000, 15:00GMT+2**

**Race Summary:** WHATSINADREAM ran on from a long way back (wide draw) when 2nd over 1600m last time and, on that evidence, should have more to offer stepped up to this distance from a wide draw, so will be hard to beat. THE SUMMONS has been runner-up in her last 2 starts over further, including against male rivals, and is likely to pose a threat. HELEN'S BLUSH is held on form by that rival but should improve so could get closer. SONG, HALLOWEEN and MIDNIGHT TRYST are all likely improvers who could earn minor money.

### **Kenilworth, 16.01.2021, Race 4, Gallops, 1600m, Turf, R90.000, 15:35GMT+2**

**Race Summary:** Good race. Unbeaten KOMMETDIEDING confirmed the promise of his debut win by accounting for a quality field over 1200m next time out. He is open to any amount of improvement stepped up in trip for the first time and is best followed until beaten. Should he not prove as effective over this distance, LIBERTY HALL is likely to pose a threat. The latter has found form and consistency off higher marks recently and should go well again. Both ARCTIC DRIFT and CAPTAIN FLINDERS have lively winning chances and should make their presence felt. Consistent FIREALLEY is on the up and is another with a shout in an intriguing contest.

### **Kenilworth, 16.01.2021, Race 5, Gallops, 1600m, Turf, R65.000, 16:10GMT+2**

**Race Summary:** Tricky. THE SECOND WAVE was returning from a break when winning over 1400m last time out at the expense of Legitimate, who had previously beaten subsequent winners ROSTROPOVICH

and JUAN CARLOS. Will be fitter, so should have more to offer stepped up in trip after that winning comeback. The latter, a winner over course and distance recently, is progressive and highly regarded, and from a good draw may represent value on his handicap debut. SALVATOR MUNDI improved in his first start after gelding to shed his maiden tag over a shorter trip and is another likely to play a leading role going 1600m. ALL LIT UP, SECRET GLIDER and TIMES NEW ROMAN are capable of getting into the picture.

**Kenilworth, 16.01.2021, Race 6, Gallops, 1200m, Turf, R60.000, 16:45GMT+2**

**Race Summary:** Wide open. BRAVE NEW WORLD built on the promise of her debut 2nd by easily accounting for her maiden rivals over this track and trip, whereas fellow last-start maiden winner ARC LAMP won at the first attempt over course and distance. Both have bright futures and are open to any amount of improvement, so should have a role to play if making the progress expected of them. GAYLEACTIC STAR and GLACIER GOLD are bright prospects in their own right. They're closely matched on recent form and likely to keep their lesser-exposed rivals honest, so must be included. MISS MILLSTREAM and WINDSOR BEAT weren't far off that pair in a recent meeting and could make their presence felt on these terms. CIOLLUM'S DELIGHT won a work riders' maiden on debut but could also be anything, so worth including. Tricky!
