EUROPE - 16th September 2020

R11 - BEVERLEY | 20:15 | GBP £5,400 | SKIRLAUGH MEDIAN AUCTION MAIDEN STAKES (DIV 1)

5	YORKSHIRE PIRLO	Just missed out when beaten a long neck second at Musselburgh (good) over 1000m as favourite in latest outing. Winning chance.
2	COBWEB CORNER	Needs to bounce back after an underwhelming performance last start, if he can replicate the form of a third place run at Ascot (1200m, good-firm) two back then he can stack up today. Rates highly here and worth another chance.
7	AQUAMAS	Making improvements on debut but still not finding the frame when fourth last at Ripon (1000m, good-slow). In the mix this start could sneak a place.
9	SOVEREIGN MOON	Unraced filly by Swiss Spirit out of Rivas Rhapsody. Is worth including among the chances.
3	EQUATE	Missed the frame when making debut over 1000m at Thirsk (good-firm) after going forward early. Likely to be much improved for this. Capable of going close.

R12 - BEVERLEY | 20:50 | GBP £5,400 | SKIRLAUGH MEDIAN AUCTION MAIDEN STAKES (DIV 2)

5	LAZYITIS	Has been a model of consistency this time in. Winning chance here.
4	TAHONTA	Went forward on debut over 1200m at Haydock Park (soft) but faded and missed the frame. Should be much improved this time. Rates strongly and expected to feature.
6	PANORAMIC	Unraced filly by Helmet out of Jubilant Queen. Tough to line up and betting likely to provide best guide.
7	SHE'S A DEVA	Wasn't expected to do much at York (good) when ninth over 1090m. Can do much better with the run under her belt.
8	TWICE ADAAY	Two-year-old filly who hit the frame on debut over 1000m at Catterick (soft), finishing third and beaten 9 lengths. Should come on from that run and is worth including in the multiples.

R13 - BEVERLEY | 21:25 | GBP £6,300 | WEEL EBF FILLIES' NOVICE STAKES (PLUS 10/GBB RACE)

1	ZEYAADAH	Showed good speed on debut on the all weather at Chelmsford (1600m, standard/normal) before drawing to the lead and boxing on well to score. Aided by the small field again here and will give a big sight.
7	STRANGERONTHE SHORE	Made debut at Redcar (1220m, soft) and turned in a handy run when 2.5 lengths over 1220m jumped at very long odds. Battled home well on debut and can feature with a bit of improvement.
10	WISE JUDGEMENT	Two-year-old filly facing the starter for the first time. Out of Group 3 winning dam Discreet Brief. Has the pedigree so watch for leads from market fluctuations.
6	HORSEFLY	Unraced filly by first season sire Camelot out of Forthefirstime. Capable of a fair run.
3	COUGAR ANNIE	Two-year-old filly facing the starter for the first time. By first season Toronado out of Group 2 winning dam La Pomme D'amour. Has the pedigree so watch for leads from market fluctuations.

R14 - BEVERLEY | 22:00 | GBP £6,300 | CHURCHILL TYRES EBF NOVICE AUCTION STAKES

2	BRANSTON LION	Good effort when second at Musselburgh (soft) over 1430m last start. Has strong claims in this race based on latest outing. Winning chance.
1	URBAN WAR	Broke maiden status at latest outing when winning at Ripon (1600m, good) over 1600m, and faces a rise in class this start. Looking well suited this start.
7	SOLID GOLD	Was safely held on debut when fifth and beaten 2 lengths at Ascot (1200m, good-slow). Should be much improved this time. Expected to be competitive.
6	SIM CARD	Missed the frame when making debut over 1400m at Sandown Park (good-slow) after going forward early. Likely to be much improved for this. Rates well and shapes as one to consider.
3	GHOSTLY	Improved on debut but still not finding a place or win, last start was sixth at Kempton Park All Weather (1600m, standard/normal). In the mix this start could sneak a place.

6	AL KHABEER	Is overdue for a win with three placings from five runs this campaign but did race a little below best last time when midfield at Hamilton Park (2400m, soft). Rates highly here and expected to be in the finish.
4	COTE D'AZUR	Has not been far away in recent times. Ran well at Ripon (good) when fourth over 2400m last start. Drops back -423m in distance. 41 day freshen up between runs. Ready to improve on last run. Winning chance.
1	FIVE HELMETS	Struggling for form this campaign, the latest when 4 lengths sixth over 2000m at Lingfield (good). Has minor claims.
2	REGAL MIRAGE	Has a honest overall record, last start scoring over 2010m at this track (good-firm). Likely to prove hard to hold out.
15	WILL SOMMERS	Fitter for two runs from a spell and looks ready to show best after placing over 2400m at Hamilton Park (soft) on September 1. Include among the chances.
