

RACE 1: SKIRLAUGH MEDIAN AUCTION MAIDEN STAKES (DIV 1) Yorkshire Pirlo
Cobweb Corner Aquamas It could be a case of third-time lucky for
YORKSHIRE PIRLO, who has been narrowly beaten in both starts thus far and is ideally drawn
here in stall two. Cobweb Corner had shaped promisingly at York and Ascot prior to struggling
back on the Knavesmire last time. This is a lot less competitive than that nursery and it's too
soon to be writing him off, while Aquamas also has place credentials.

Island at 33-1 when last of 12 on his latest outing at York over 6f (good) last month.
- 3 EQUATE Foaled 28 Feb. Half-brother to Masaru, won twice between 6f and 1m.
Beaten 10l behind Nomadic Empire at 40-1 when seventh of 10 on his racecourse debut at
Thirsk over 5f (good to firm) last month.
- 4 PIVOTING Foaled 17 Feb. Dam a lightly raced maiden. Beaten 9l behind Twilight
Heir at 33-1 when seventh of 12 on his racecourse debut at Catterick over 6f (soft) earlier this
month.
- 5 YORKSHIRE PIRLO Foaled 12 May. Half-brother to Tahoe, won four times at 5f.
Placed in both starts. Beaten a neck by International Girl when second of 9 at 7-4fav on his
latest outing at Musselburgh over 5f (good) in July.
- 6 AMAZING ANNA Foaled 29 Mar. Half-sister to Shades Of Mist, won at 6f. Beaten
17l behind Mamba Wamba at 80-1 when last of 13 on her racecourse debut at York over 5f
(good) earlier this month.
- 7 AQUAMAS Foaled 14 Mar. Dam a lightly raced maiden. Unplaced in both starts.
Finished 9l behind Winter Power when fourth of 8 at 25-1 on her latest outing at Ripon over 5f
(good to soft) earlier this month.
- 8 LIVVIE Foaled 21 Jan. Dam won at 1m.
- 9 SOVEREIGN MOON Foaled 23 Apr. Full sister to Saras Hope, won at 5f.
- 10 UMAFIKA Foaled 28 Feb. Dam won at 5f. Unplaced in both starts. Well beaten at
100-1 behind Jianzi when last of 12 on her latest outing at Pontefract over 6f (good to firm) in
July.

RACE 2: SKIRLAUGH MEDIAN AUCTION MAIDEN STAKES (DIV 2) Tahonta
Lazyitis Twice Adaay Lazyitis has placed on her last three starts and is likely to be in the shake-up again, while Twice Adaay merits consideration following his pleasing debut performance at Catterick. However, TAHONTA was even more promising when fourth on his introduction at Haydock, sharp out of the gates and showing up well for a long way before fading late on, and this drop down from 6f will suit him. Newcomer Panoramic adds further spice to the race.

- 3 SOCIALITY Foaled 25 Apr. Half-brother to Red Sabor, won three times at 5f and 6f. Unplaced in both starts. Beaten 20l behind Dark Shift at 100-1 when 9th of 10 on his latest outing at Ascot over 6f (good to soft) earlier this month.
- 4 TAHONTA Foaled 7 Mar. Dam won twice at 5f. Finished 6l behind Tanmawwy when fourth of 10 at 12-1 on his racecourse debut at Haydock over 6f (soft) earlier this month.
- 5 LAZYITIS Foaled 5 Mar. Placed in three of four starts. Third of 12 behind Roman Encounter beaten 1 3/4l at 8-1 on her latest outing over this course and distance (good) last month.
- 6 PANORAMIC Foaled 3 Apr. Half-sister to Royal Residence, won twice at 6f.
- 7 SHE'S A DEVA Foaled 13 Apr. Half-sister to Mininggold, won six times at 5f and 6f. Unplaced in both starts. Beaten 10l behind Mamba Wamba at 300-1 when 9th of 13 on her latest outing at York over 5f (good) earlier this month.
- 8 TWICE ADAAY Foaled 14 Apr. Half-sister to Poet's Pride, won three times at 5f and 7f. Third of 12 behind Ey Up It's Maggie beaten 9l at 14-1 on her racecourse debut at Catterick over 5f (soft) last month.
- 9 ZOOM STAR Foaled 2 Apr. Dam unraced. Beaten 11l behind Roman Encounter at 33-1 when 11th of 12 on her racecourse debut over this course and distance (good) last month.

RACE 3: WEEL EBF FILLIES' NOVICE STAKES (PLUS 10/GBB RACE) Zeyaadah Strangerontheshore Cougar Annie ZEYAADAH was a taking a winner on her debut over 1m at Chelmsford last month, particularly as she was slowly away and looked green early on. The daughter of Tamayuz can only improve for that experience and she is fancied to follow up under a penalty. Strangerontheshore defied odds of 125/1 when a promising third on her debut at Redcar and she is likely to give another good account, while Cougar Annie and Horsefly are just two of a few interesting newcomers in the line-up.

- 2 CELTIC EMPRESS Foaled 5 Mar. Half-sister to Vindolanda, won three times at 1m 4f and 1m 6f.
- 3 COUGAR ANNIE Foaled 28 Apr. Dam won five times between 1m 1f and 1m 4f including two Group 2 races.
- 4 FLORA'S AURA Foaled 9 Apr. Half-sister to Golden Desert, won five times at 6f and 7f. Well beaten at 80-1 behind Time Scale when last of 12 on her racecourse debut at Chepstow over 6f (good to soft) in June.
- 5 HOLY ENDEAVOUR Foaled 26 Feb. Half-sister to Missed Call, won twice between 1m 2f and 1m 4f.
- 6 HORSEFLY Foaled 3 Apr. Half-sister to Time And Place, won twice at 5f and 6f.
- 7 STRANGERONTHESHORE Foaled 26 Feb. Half-sister to Dangerous Ends, won four times at 1m and 1m 2f. Third of 12 behind Italian Breeze beaten 2 1/2l at 125-1 on her racecourse debut at Redcar over 6f (soft) last month.
- 8 WESTERN BEAT Foaled 10 Apr. Half-sister to Alfredo, won five times in all weather flat races at 2m and in NH flat race at 1m 6f. Beaten 16l behind Northern Express at 80-1 when eighth of 11 on her racecourse debut over this course and distance (soft) last month.
- 9 WILDCITYDIVA Foaled 28 Mar. Dam a lightly raced maiden.
- 10 WISE JUDGEMENT Foaled 16 Apr. Half-sister to Secret Brief, won four times between 6f and 1m.

RACE 4: CHURCHILL TYRES EBF NOVICE AUCTION STAKES Urban War Solid Gold Branston Lion URBAN WAR built on her debut third at Lingfield with an impressive success at Ripon and Amy Murphy's colt appears capable of defying a penalty based on that victory. Solid Gold ran with promise when fifth at Ascot earlier in the month and he is likely to step forward for the extra furlong, while the form of Branston Lion's second at Musselburgh can see him enter the reckoning.

- 1 URBAN WAR Foaled 18 Apr. Dam unraced. Won on his latest outing when 11-8fav at Ripon over 1m (good to soft) last month, beating Party Spirit by 3 1/2l.
- 2 BRANSTON LION Foaled 17 Feb. Placed twice in five starts. Beaten 1 3/4l by Heights Of Abraham when second of 10 at 5-1 on his latest outing at Musselburgh over 7f (soft) last month.
- 3 GHOSTLY Foaled 26 Mar. Half-brother to Now I'm A Believer, won at 1m. Unplaced in both starts. Finished 5l behind King Tiger when sixth of 14 at 28-1 on his latest outing at Kempton over 1m earlier this month.
- 4 IVYNATOR Foaled 15 Mar. Half-brother to Vera Blue, won at 1m 2f.
- 5 NORTHERN GENERAL Foaled 28 Mar. Half-brother to Star Of Paris, won four times between 5f and 1m. Unplaced in both starts. Well beaten at 200-1 behind Ataser when 12th of 14 on his latest outing at Ripon over 6f (good) in July.
- 6 SIM CARD Foaled 27 Apr. Half-brother to Drop Kick Murphi, won four times at 6f. Finished 11l behind Huddleton Mac when sixth of 14 at 40-1 on his racecourse debut at Sandown over 7f (good to soft) last month.
- 7 SOLID GOLD Foaled 23 Feb. Half-brother to Feel Glorious, won four times at 6f and 1m. Finished 2l behind Prince Of Abington when fifth of 8 at 14-1 on his racecourse debut at Ascot over 6f (good to soft) earlier this month.

RACE 5: CHURCHILL TYRES A GREAT BRITISH BRAND HANDICAP Regal Mirage
Al Khabeer Ring Of Gold REGAL MIRAGE arrives in search of his fourth
course success having returned to winning ways on his most recent outing over this distance
and a 4lb rise might not be enough to stop the six-year-old from doubling up. Al Khabeer chased
home the selection on his penultimate start and could bounce back to form following a
disappointing run at Hamilton, while Ring Of Gold is of interest on his handicap debut after a
couple of promising efforts.

Finished 4l behind Torochica when sixth of 10 at 5-1 on his latest outing at Lingfield over 1m 2f
(good) earlier this month.

2 REGAL MIRAGE Has won nine races from 1m 1f to 1m 4f on ground varying from
good to firm to soft. A winner at 17-2 over this course and distance (good to firm) on his latest
outing last month, beating Al Khabeer by 1/2l.

3 ZIHAAM Winner of six races from 1m 1f to 1m 4f on good to firm and good ground.
Beaten 13l behind Prince Alex at 20-1 when eighth of 10 on his latest outing here over 1m 4f
(soft) last month. Has won twice at Beverley this season.

4 COTE D'AZUR Winner of seven races from 7f to 1m 2f on good to firm and good
ground and on the all-weather, but last win was over two years ago. Finished 1 3/4l behind
Bollin Joan when fourth of 7 at 11-2 on his latest outing at Ripon over 1m 4f (good) last month.

5 FANNIE BY GASLIGHT She has won three times from 1m 2f to 1m 4f on ground
varying from firm to heavy. Third of 9 behind Colony Queen beaten 3 1/2l at 7-2 on her latest
outing at Newbury over 1m 2f (heavy) in October last year.

6 AL KHABEER Placed in three of six starts. Well beaten at 9-4 behind Doubling Dice
when fourth of 6 on his latest outing at Hamilton over 1m 4f (soft) earlier this month.

7 DR RIO He has won three times from 7f to 1m 1f on good and soft ground and on
the all-weather. Beaten 19l behind Beechwood Jude at 11-1 when seventh of 11 on his latest
outing at Catterick over 1m 4f (heavy) last month.

8 RING OF GOLD Placed in both starts. Third of 12 behind Bonneval beaten 1/2l at
25-1 on his latest outing at Redcar over 1m (soft) last month.

9 BIT OF A QUIRKE Winner of seven races at 1m 2f on ground varying from good to
firm to good to soft. Third of 9 behind Regal Mirage beaten 1 1/2l at 28-1 on his latest outing
over this course and distance (good to firm) last month.

10 EL NASERI Placed in three of six starts. Finished 7l behind Silver Samurai when sixth
of 7 at 17-2 on his latest outing at Redcar over 1m (good to firm) in July.

11 VAMPISH Successful twice at 1m 4f on good ground and on the all-weather. Beaten 10l behind Prince Alex at 33-1 when last of 7 on her latest outing at Leicester over 1m 4f (good to soft) earlier this month.

12 THOMAS CRANMER Winner of five races from 7f to 1m 2f on good to firm and good ground, but last win was over two years ago. Beaten 7l behind Society Red at 16-1 when eighth of 12 on his latest outing at Chester over 1m 2f (good) earlier this month.

13 LORD TORRANAGA A winner at 1m 4f on the all-weather. Beaten 7l behind Gift Of Kings at 10-1 when eighth of 14 on his latest outing at Newcastle over 1m 2f earlier this month.

14 JUPITER ROAD He has won four times from 7f to 1m 2f on ground varying from good to firm to soft. A winner at 11-1 at Ripon over 1m 2f (soft) on his latest outing last month, beating Royal Shaheen by a head. Has also won at Beverley this season.

15 WILL SOMMERS Placed once in four starts. Beaten 15l by Doubling Dice when second of 6 at 11-8fav on his latest outing at Hamilton over 1m 4f (soft) earlier this month.
