CUBAN BREEZE was only beaten a neck off this mark at Catterick 10 days ago and she has to be given the utmost respect this afternoon as she is 4lb well in. Prospect has been knocking hard on the door of late and he could go very well on his nursery debut, while Miss Nay Never and Avior Star are others who merit plenty of respect.

Any significant market move for any of the newcomers would be interesting.

This step up in trip could suit the three-year-old, and he is fancied to go well now tackling handicap company. River Icon returns to the Flat off a fair mark after finishing second over hurdles at Perth recently, but the hat-trick seeker TRUMPET MAN can take the beating. A further 6lb penalty isn't ideal, but he is progressive and has handled testing ground in the past.
