

RACE 11: NAPOLEONS CASINO BRADFORD NOVICE STAKES (CLASS 5) (2YO ONLY) (FROM PONTEFRAC T RACE 1) Sir Maxi Roydmoor Mr Trevor SIR
 MAXI proved best of the rest behind an impressive winner at Windsor on debut and the 155,000gns buy, who is a half-brother to three winners, won't need to find too much improvement to better that opening second. Roydmoor has produced some fine efforts in defeat this season and is now well worth trying at 6f for the second time. Mr Trevor hasn't been disgraced in his two outings so far and has the ideal draw to mount a strong challenge this time.

PRODUCTION appreciated the drop back to 6f when finishing second at Kempton earlier this month and the four-year-old could have a huge say in this off a 1lb lower mark, with Hannah Fraser taking over in the saddle and removing a useful 7lb with her claim. Lezardrieux went close at Catterick last time and is of interest off the same figure, while Richard Fahey's Anna Maria makes appeal off a rating which continues to fall and she could be dangerous from the foot of the handicap.

STORMY GIRL landed a Listed contest over course and distance on her penultimate start and lost little in defeat when upped to 7f for a competitive Group 3 at Doncaster last week. The switch to handicap company could see Rebecca Menzies' consistent performer record a second track victory and she rates as the one to beat. Auchterarder got the better of a useful operator when winning at Lingfield in February and is one of two to consider representing Mark Johnston alongside recent Salisbury third Mountain Brave. Last Surprise got on the scoresheet at Kempton recently and is also of note off a 3lb higher rating.

The only runner off a lighter weight is Lizzie Loch, who has been knocking on the door and should run well again. The first-time visored Alexanderthegreat also has a squeak.

Highwaygrey Gift Of Kings Archie Perkins It might pay to side with HIGHWAYGREY, a three-time C&D winner who had been in cracking form before a slightly disappointing effort on soft ground at Haydock latest. Back on a faster surface, at a track he clearly loves, don't be surprised if he bounces right back to form. Gift Of Kings justified favouritism at Newcastle last time and warrants respect switching back to turf off only 3lb higher mark, while the dropped-in-class Archie Perkins is no forlorn hope from the opposite end of the weights.
