easy Goodwood scorer Alkumait could go well at longer odds.

The second, Sacred, was previously runner-up in the Queen Mary at Royal Ascot and has since finished a close-up second at Doncaster in the Flying Childers. Scarlet Bear (third) and Illykato (fourth) are closely matched having performed creditably in defeat behind the excellent Happy Romance in Group 3 Dick Poole at Salisbury, and both warrant a place on the shortlist.
