3rd Pick: BABY TWINS (3)

Draws a good gate to find a forward position in running. The last start second to War Room was a great run, and the inside gate gives him every possible chance to replicate last start, respect.

4th Pick: MAY (9)

It's fair to say his first run up in class 4 was far from terrible and he had genuine excuses in the run. App Clyde Leck jumps back on board who won on him two starts back and at the weights, looks a live chance in this event.
