RACE 2: RACING TO SCHOOL EBFSTALLIONS.COM NOVICE STAKES (GBB RACE)

Golden War Sydney Street Rich King

GOLDEN WAR returned to what he achieved on debut when runner-up over C&D last month and the son of Churchill appears to have been found a suitable opportunity to go one better in a first-time hood having been gelded. Sydney Street improved from his debut when third at Ffos Las and he is capable of a decent showing along with Rich King, who has shaped with promise on both his starts.

- 1 CAVENDISH Foaled 3 Apr. Dam won twice at 1m 4f and 1m 5f. Finished 11l behind Nuvolari when fifth of 10 at 10-1 on his racecourse debut at Epsom over 7f (good) earlier this month.
- 2 GOLDEN WAR Foaled 26 Jan. Placed twice in four starts. Beaten 1l by Implore when second of 14 at 4-1 on his latest outing over this course and distance (good) last month.

- 5 RICH KING Foaled 11 Mar. Half-brother to Epsom Icon, won three times at 7f and 1m including a Group 3 race. Placed once in two starts. Third of 11 behind Leopold Bloom beaten 1/2l at 2-1fav on his latest outing at Thirsk over 7f (good) last month.
- 6 SAMUEL SPADE Foaled 16 Feb. Half-brother to Sally Jane, won twice at 7f and 1m.
- 7 SYDNEY STREET Foaled 3 Mar. Half-brother to She Do, won at 6f. Placed once in two starts. Third of 11 behind Ring Of Beara beaten 5l at 50-1 on his latest outing at Ffos Las over 7f (good) last month.
- 8 THE PREDICTOR Foaled 20 Feb. Half-brother to Top Buck, won at 1m.

La Rav Arranmore Give It Some Teddy

LA RAV returned to winning ways over C&D last month when getting the better of Arranmore, who reopposes having filled the same place subsequently at Carlisle, and the seven-year-old is expected to handle a 5lb rise for that success. Arranmore has to be respected in his own right based on recent performances, while Give It Some Teddy and Urban War are both likely to enter calculations following their consistency.

- 2 LA RAV Winner of five races from 7f to 1m on good to firm and good ground and on the all-weather. A winner at 16-1 over this course and distance (good to firm) on his latest outing last month, beating Arranmore by 1 1/4l.
- 3 QUIET ASSASSIN A winner at 7f on soft ground. Well beaten at 150-1 behind Snowfall when last of 7 on her latest outing in the Group 3 Tattersalls Musidora Stakes at York over 1m 2f (good to soft) in May.
- 4 URBAN WAR Successful at 7f and 1m on good and good to soft ground. Beaten 3/4l by Arqoob when second of 9 at 3-1 on his latest outing at Leicester over 1m (good to firm) last month.
- 5 ARRANMORE He has won four times from 6f to 1m on good and good to soft ground. Beaten 1 1/2l by Epic Endeavour when second of 3 at 11-8fav on his latest outing at Carlisle over 1m (good to firm) earlier this month. Has won 3 times this season.
- 6 GIVE IT SOME TEDDY Has won eight races from 6f to 1m 1f on ground varying from good to firm to heavy. Beaten 2 3/4l by Farasi Lane when second of 16 at 8-1 on his latest outing at Sandown over 1m (good to soft) last month.
- 7 DANIELSLYER He has won four times from 6f to 7f on good to firm and good to soft ground and on the all-weather. Beaten 8l behind La Rav at 14-1 when eighth of 9 on his latest outing over this course and distance (good to firm) last month. Has won at Redcar and Newcastle this season.
- 8 UGO GREGORY Winner of six races from 6f to 7f on ground varying from good to heavy. Third of 8 behind Muntadab beaten 1l at 9-2 on his latest outing at Chester over 7f (good) earlier this month. Has won twice at Beverley this season.
- 9 LITTLE JO Winner of seven races at 1m on ground varying from good to firm to soft and on the all-weather. Finished 2 1/2l behind Enigmatic when sixth of 10 at 25-1 on his latest outing at Pontefract over 1m (good to firm) earlier this month.
- 10 BLU BOY He has won three times from 7f to 1m on good to firm ground and on the all-weather. Last of 3 behind Cosmos Raj beaten 6l at 5-6fav on his latest outing at Ripon over 1m (good to soft) last month. Has won 3 times this season.
- 11 BLOWING WIND Placed in four of ten starts. Finished 4l behind Jack Daniel when fourth of 13 at 4-6fav on his latest outing at Redcar over 7f (good) last month.
- 12 KING'S PAVILION Winner of seven races from 7f to 1m on ground varying from good to firm to heavy. Beaten 17l behind Motarajel at 7-1 when seventh of 8 on his latest outing here over 1m (good to firm) last month.

RACE 4: EDDIE AND VIOLET SMITH CONDITIONS STAKES

Brando Danzeno Tarboosh

BRANDO was last seen when running a gallant fourth in the Group 1 Maurice de Gheest and, although he hasn't been seen over the minimum trip since 2016, the nine-year-old is favoured to land the spoils. Danzeno has been an inconsistent customer this term but, considering his two recent wins came in similar contests, he merits plenty of respect. The course-and-distance winner Tarboosh completes the shortlist.

- 1 DANZENO Has won nine races from 5f to 6f on ground varying from good to firm to soft. A winner at 9-4 at Nottingham over 5f (good to soft) on his latest outing last month, beating Dubai Station by 1/2l. Has also won at Haydock this season.
- 2 DUBAI STATION Successful at 5f and 6f on soft ground and on the all-weather. Beaten 3 1/2l by Roulston Scar when second of 3 at 6-5 on his latest outing at Leicester over 5f (good to firm) earlier this month.
- 3 TARBOOSH Has won 12 races from 5f to 7f on ground varying from good to firm to soft and on the all-weather. Third of 6 behind Khaadem beaten 2 1/4l at 15-2 on his latest outing at Doncaster over 5f (good to firm) earlier this month.
- 4 BRANDO Has won nine races from 5f to 6f on ground varying from good to firm to soft, but last win was over two years ago. Finished 2l behind Marianafoot when fourth of 12 at 66-1fav on his latest outing in the Group 1 LARC Prix Maurice De Gheest - Group 1 at Deauville over 6f (good to soft) last month.

Dreams Of Thunder could have the ability to follow her home after edging closer to a first win over this trip, while Coffee Mehmas completes the shortlist.

- 2 DREAMS OF THUNDER Foaled 22 Feb. Placed twice in four starts. Beaten 9l behind Zain Claudette at 100-1 when 9th of 10 on her latest outing in the Group 2 Sky Bet Lowther Stakes at York over 6f (good) last month.
- 3 EL DIVINE Foaled 26 Apr. Half-sister to Alejandro, won eight times between 5f and 1m. Unplaced in both starts. Beaten 11l behind Breeze Easy at 100-1 when seventh of 12 on her latest outing at Carlisle over 6f (good) last month.
