It might be worth siding with BEECHWOOD DONNA, who won impressively at this venue on debut and ran well here on her penultimate outing too. Pivoting took a step in the right direction when second over C&D latest and is another to note.

Harbour Vision is a model of consistency, Markazi commands respect now eased in grade, while the likes of Idoapologise and Kentuckyconnection arrive in good order too.

Ornate has taken on some tough assignments this term but is another pace angle in the race to consider.
