RACE 1: DOWNLOAD THE TOTE PLACEPOT APP FUTURE STAYERS' EBF MAIDEN STAKES (PLUS 10)

Outback Boy Juan De Montalban

Act Of Wisdom

OUTBACK BOY stepped forward from his racecourse debut at Ascot when running on to finish third at Haydock earlier in the month and the step up in distance promises to unlock further progression from Mark Johnston's colt. Juan De Montalban is likely to have benefited from his first start when fourth at Haydock last month, while a set of cheekpieces are likely to aid the cause of Act Of Wisdom, a brother of Breeders Cup Juvenile Turf hero Line Of Duty.

1ACT OF WISDOMFoaled 30 Mar. Full brother to Line Of Duty, won three timesat 1m and 1m 1f including a Group 1 race. Finished 6l behind Lightening Shore when sixth of 7 at 11-2 on his racecourse debut at Kempton over 1m earlier this month.

2 JUAN DE MONTALBAN Foaled 11 Feb. Dam a lightly raced maiden. Finished 51 behind River Alwen when fourth of 10 at 25-1 on his racecourse debut at Haydock over 1m (good to soft) last month.

3 KING FRANKEL Foaled 18 May. Full brother to Eminent, won three times at 1m and 1m 2f including a Group 2 race. Finished 12l behind Surprise Exhibit when last of 6 at 11-4 on his racecourse debut at Wolverhampton over 1m 1f last month.

4 OUTBACK BOY Foaled 29 Apr. Half-brother to Expressionist, won at 5f. Placed once in two starts. Third of 10 behind Pleasant Man beaten 3 1/2l at 8-1 on his latest outing at Haydock over 1m (soft) earlier this month.

5 NIGHT OF HOPE Foaled 10 May. Half-sister to Set To Music, won five times between 1m 2f and 1m 4f.

Dawaam has been eased 1lb for his latest run on the all-weather and remains open to improvement, though it might be worth siding with HORTZADAR, who won a shade cosily over this trip at Ripon last time and may be capable of shaking off a 3lb rise in the ratings. Plantadream is respected as he bids to back up his Ascot victory under today's pilot, while Willie John has a big run in him at some point and, like Silent Attack, he is entitled to improve for a recent drop in the handicap.

The Lamplighter Lihou Al Dawodiya

Lihou arrives following two cracking efforts at Chester, win and placed, and should make his presence felt, while Al Dawodiya won gamely at Lingfield recently and is likely to show up well again. However, from further down the weights, narrow preference is for THE LAMPLIGHTER. He built on a couple of solid placed efforts, including in class 2 company over course and distance, when scoring comfortably at Kempton and looks sure to play a leading role returning to turf off just a 1lb higher mark.

3 AL DAWODIYA Successful twice at 6f on firm and good ground. A winner at 7-2 at Lingfield over 6f (good) on her latest outing earlier this month, beating Flippa The Strippa by 1/2l. Has also won at Bath this season.

4 SPANISH ANGEL Successful twice at 5f on good to firm ground. Finished 6l behind Hamish Macbeth when fourth of 6 at 13-2 on his latest outing at Yarmouth over 6f (good to firm) earlier this month.

5 CHAIRMANIC A winner at 6f on soft ground. Finished 16l behind Musicality when last of 6 at 9-1 on his latest outing at Newmarket over 6f (soft) last month.

6 MINHAAJ Successful twice at 5f on good to firm ground and on the allweather. AIR PILOT won this last year after a long break and could repeat the trick here for Ralph Beckett, who wouldn't have brought the 11-year-old back into training this season if he didn't think the veteran was capable of being competitive at the very least. Mythical Magic lost out to the classy Logician at Doncaster earlier this month but faces nothing of that calibre here, while Bullfinch is unbeaten on synthetic surfaces but has to prove himself on grass.
