BEAUTIFUL NEWS looks the one to beat on her handicap debut. William Haggas' filly has been edging closer to the target with each start thus far and will appreciate stepping back up from 5f. Mr Trevor has shown enough in three novice races to suggest that he can be competitive off an opening mark of 65, while first-time blinkered Tashbeeh also warrants respect cutting back from 7f. Showtime Elle and Avior Star, who are closely matched on their recent Thirsk clash, are other names to note.
