AUSTRALIA - 24th March 2022

## R1 - ALBURY | 12:25 | AUD \$30,000 | MEREDITH ROOF PLUMBING MDN

| 3  | BRILLIANT SPEED | Returned from a spell last start with a sound fourth over 1000m at Corowa. Strips fitter and a bold showing is expected.                |
| 2  | NOBLE EXCEPTION | Has not raced since finishing 5 lengths away in fifth over 1600m at Wagga on October 16. Expected to run well.                          |
| 16 | SHINY ROCK      | Was in the leading division around the bend but faded to miss the placings over 1400m at Towong last time out. Worth including.         |
| 1  | I AM RICHENUFF  | First starter who looks ready to fire following a trial win over 1000m at Wagga on March 17. A betting push will add to the confidence. |

## R2 - HAWKESBURY | 12:40 | AUD \$35,000 | KOHNKE'S OWN MDN PLATE

| 9  | NANO STAR         | Stepping out at this track for the first time. Last appeared when she finished third over 1550m at Canterbury on March 10. Racing well. Has strong claims.  |
| 13 | SMART LITTLE MISS | Has opened her career in good style with two minor placings from four starts. Finished second at her most recent appearance over 1200m at Gosford. Great chance to break through.                     |
| 14 | STALKING          | Second up from a spell. Finished second when resuming over 1300m at Kembla Grange on February 22 beaten a head. Will appreciate longer journey at this stage of the prep. One of the main contenders. |
| 8  | LEGAL CHOICE      | Stepping out at this circuit for the first time. Last appeared when she finished fourth over 1400m at Newcastle on March 4. Likely to prove hard to hold out.   |
| 2  | LUKEY LUKE        | Resumed with a respectable fifth over 1300m at Kembla Grange, beaten just 1.5 lengths. Is a definite threat in this line-up.  |

## R3 - ALBURY | 13:05 | AUD \$30,000 | DLG ALUMINIUM & GLAZING (C1)

| 6 | DIAMOND STAR  | Was out of the placings two back but turned things around more recently, beaten one length when second over 1400m at Canberra. Well placed and looks tough to stop again.                     |
| 3 | COME ON HARRY | Scored over 1375m at Cowra last start when lining up for the first time. Will take a lot from that run and is sure to play a big role.  |
| 2 | BIANCO VILANO | Scored two back at Wagga then just missed last time when second over 1400m at this track. Looks very hard to toss.  |
| 8 | ANCHORAGE     | Broke through for a maiden win over 1200m two back at Wagga then could only manage fourth last start over 1200m at Goulburn. Better than the last run suggests and can feature in the finish. |
| 5 | LEGAL AWARD   | Landed his maiden win last time out over 1400m at Wagga. Shapes as a top chance again.  |

## R4 - HAWKESBURY | 13:20 | AUD \$35,000 | BUY BETTER @ INGLIS 2022-BM68

| 7 | BELLA VIOLET   | Stepping back in trip after finishing fifth over 1900m at Canterbury last time out. Can improve on last start and gets her chance.   |
| 3 | STEPLEE        | Kept coming last time over 1400m at Tamworth to finish sixth. Should appreciate the extra ground. Ready to peak after four runs back and looks sure to feature.                  |
| 5 | VANDANGLE      | Talented gelding who won last time over 1600m at Coonamble. Form good for this and looks one of the major hopes.   |
| 1 | FINE RUBY      | Has not raced since finishing 6 lengths away in sixth over 1800m at this track on October 21. Can return in winning form.  |
| 2 | CRYSTAL WATERS | Usually reliable type who ran well below her best last start when 6 lengths adrift in eighth over 1400m at Newcastle. Better than that last effort and cannot be underestimated. |

## R5 - ALBURY | 13:40 | AUD \$50,000 | BAXTERS CONCRETE ALBURY MILE

| 6 | ISLAND BAY BOY | Handy gelding who returned to the winners' list last start over 1600m at Queanbeyan. Going well and can measure up.  |
| 4 | HEMMERLE       | Was below par two back at Canterbury then bounced back with a win over 1600m at Corowa last time out. Hannah Williams is engaged to ride again. One of the chief contenders. |
| 1 | MAD AS ZARIZ   | Put the writing on the wall last start when he finished a close third at Canberra over 1400m. Leading prospect.  |
| 2 | STRATEGIC PHIL | Six-year-old gelding who drops in journey from the latest outing when sixth over 2000m at Colac, finishing 4.5 lengths off the winner. One of the leading chances.           |
| 3 | ZAKERIZ        | Was 3.5 lengths from the winner in sixth when returning from a break last start over 1550m at Canterbury. Has won second up before and should do much better.                |

## R6 - HAWKESBURY | 13:55 | AUD \$35,000 | BENDIGO BANK (BM64)

| 3 | CALIFORNIA SURREAL | Scored first-up at Canterbury then couldn't repeat the dose last time when fourth at Canterbury over 1200m when beaten 1.5 lengths. Tough to beat on best figures. Can atone.  |
| 6 | TICKET TO ANYWHERE | Landed his maiden success last time as favourite out over 1200m at Gosford. Is generally thereabouts in his races. Heading the right way and should measure up again.          |
| 5 | THE POACHER        | Progressive type who opened this prep with a decisive win, scoring by 2.75 lengths over 1200m at Goulburn. Will be the testing material again.                                 |
| 7 | BEHOLDER           | Stepping out at this circuit for the first time. Last appeared when he scored over 1200m at Newcastle on February 24. Confidence high so a repeat performance is on the cards. |
| 1 | MISSION PHOENIX    | Resumes from a spell of two-and-a-half years and has recently trialled at Randwick. Worth some thought. Sure to run well first-up.   |

## R7 - ALBURY | 14:15 | AUD \$75,000 | BARLENS CITY HCP

| 5 | MAJOR TIME    | Narrowly beaten last time when third at Canberra, finishing just 0.6 lengths from the winner. Consistent and holds appeal.                                    |
| 2 | DELACOUR      | Sat close to the lead at Canberra last start and fought on well to finish a close second over 1000m. Looks tough to beat in this line-up.                     |
| 1 | CALESCENT     | Was below par two back at Canterbury then bounced back with a win over 1200m at Canberra last time out. Excellent prospects in this suitable race.            |
| 7 | NORTHERNERO   | Consistent type much improved by two runs back from a spell. Last start scored by 1.5 lengths over 1000m at Corowa. Rates highly and sure to play a big role. |
| 9 | BOOGIE WOOGIE | Last start was back on August 8 when sixth over 1400m at Wagga. Has since gone to a new yard. Sure to be prominent.   |

## R8 - HAWKESBURY | 14:30 | AUD \$35,000 | HRC MOTEL (BM64)

| 7 | LAURELIN         | Resumed at Randwick Kensington over 1000m last time out and finished sixth, beaten 2 lengths. Fitter for that run and expected to be in the finish this time.                     |
| 5 | WAY TO THE STARS | Stepping out at this track for the first time. Last appeared when he finished fourth over 1000m at Randwick Kensington on February 16. Encouraging effort last start. In the mix. |
| 1 | SHADOW BRIDGE    | Put the writing on the wall last start when he finished a close third at Canterbury over 1100m. Will take beating.  |
| 4 | ESTEEMED LADY    | Going well recently including a last start third beaten 1.1 lengths over 1100m at Randwick. Genuine type who gets her chance.   |
| 3 | MAJOR MURPHY     | Nice return last start when runner-up at Newcastle over 900m on March 4. Hard to beat.  |
