promising fifth at Hamilton off 1lb higher, beaten a length and a half after weakening close home. Nominal improvement may see him prove too speedy for both C&D third Golden Gal and the consistent Dream Deal.

2 ACONCAGUA MOUNTAIN He has won three times at 5f on good to firm ground and on the all-weather. Finished 1 1/2l behind Mews House when fifth of 8 at 5-1 on his latest outing at Hamilton over 5f (good) earlier this month.
